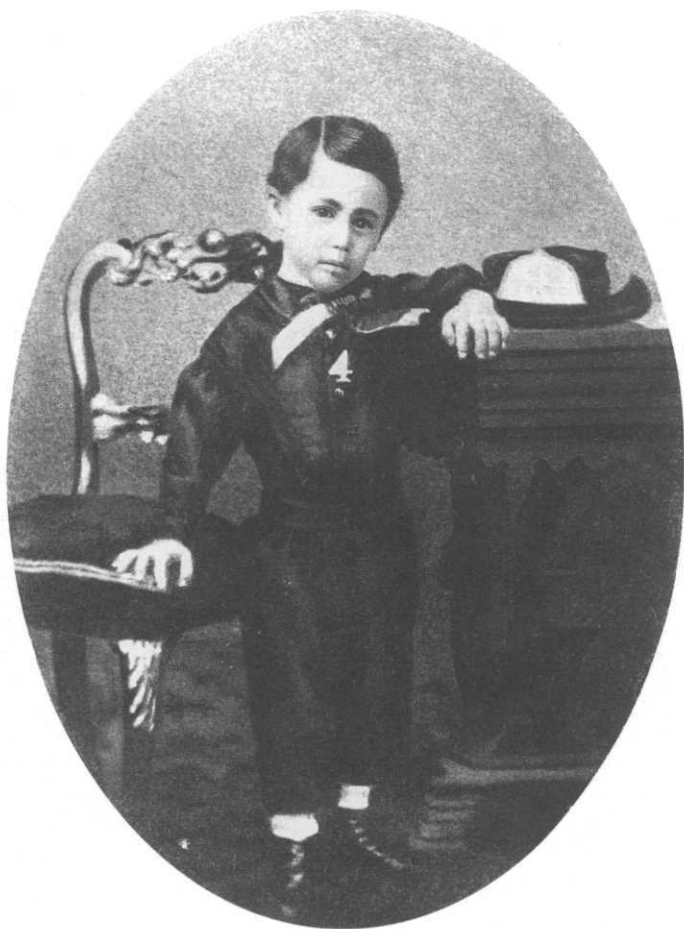

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Historical Society was founded one hundred years ago, on January 11, 1892, by leading citizens of the Kingdom of Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Historical Society began in 1892 publishing articles, papers, and books about the history of Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Historical Society now maintains a library containing a major collection of Hawaiian historical materials on the history of Hawaii and the Pacific which is open to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Historical Society sponsors lecture series on the history of Hawaii and in many ways fosters an interest in Hawaii's history in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Historical Society celebrates 100 years of service at a Centennial Luau on Saturday, January 11, 1992;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN WAIHEE, Governor of Hawaii, do hereby proclaim January 11, 1992, to be
