## JOINT RESOLUTION

Designating 1987 as the "Year of the Hawaiian".

Whereas the State of Hawaii has designated 1987 as the "Year of the Hawaiian" for the purpose of promoting increased awareness of the everlasting strength and beauty of the Hawaiian culture;

Whereas the unique heritage of Hawaii may be seen through its influence on laws and music, its appreciation of its natural

beauty, its love for people, its respect for the land and sea, and the "Aloha" spirit reflected in the lives of its people and all areas of Hawaiian life;

Whereas focusing public attention during this year on the process by which the many racial and ethnic cultures and peoples of Hawaii became one will have a positive impact on all communities; and

Whereas the people of Hawaii are an inspiration to all who pursue peace and harmony for individuals all over the world: Now, therefore, be it

1. *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
- 2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That 1987 is designated as the "Year of the Hawaiian", and
- 4 the President is authorized and requested to issue a procla-
- 5 mation calling upon the people of the United States and Fed-
- 6 eral, State, and local governments to observe the year with
- 7 appropriate programs and activities.
