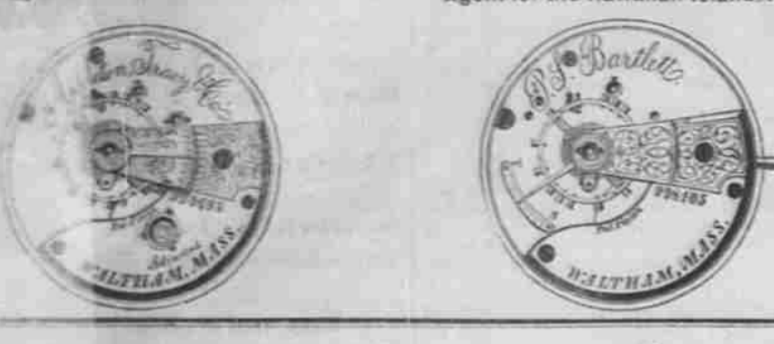

Hawaiian Gazette, WEDNESDAY, JULY 18, 1883. THE GREAT MOCK TRIAL. The following account of a jolly evening on board the steamship Zulueta, is taken from the Honolulu Herald, a spirited little brochure published by the Wasp Company, San Francisco.

Mock trials on board ship are generally great fun. The sailors on board the Zulueta on the April trip down to San Francisco had one element of jollity in it that put it ahead of all similar larks, in the estimation of every one who witnessed it. This element was comprised and expressed in the person of the defendant, Frank Spencer of the Hawaiian Islands. Spencer, a stalwart big-hearted, jolly fellow, was returning to Islands after his first trip away from them during a residence of over thirty-three years. He was wrecked on the Islands in 1849, on his way to San Francisco, and only reached the latter metropolis, as I have said, in 1882.

One morning, after we had been several days at sea, Spencer, while standing talking near the smoking-room, was publicly accused of having abstracted Captain Webber's watch, and being afterwards seized several other thefts. His horrified denial did not prevent the latter search, and he was struck speechless upon seeing the searchers bring forth from the depths of his coat pocket, not only the watch, but several handkerchiefs, table spoons, etc. It was immediately decided to solemnly try him in the dining saloon that evening. The saloon was crowded with passengers and officers, whose sympathies were pretty equally divided between the heavily ironed, gray-haired old prisoner, and the tearful plaintiff. After the delivery of jury of twelve was finally impounded, and the charges being read, it was discovered that Spencer was accused of nearly every known crime. Following as the indictment, as nearly as I can remember, and which was sworn to by Mr. Charles H. Bishop, the Honolulu barrister, and Mr. Cass Sperry, the great attorney of San Francisco:

ZULUETA, April 17, 1882. CROWS VS. SPENCER. Upon information and belief the undersigned charge the defendant in this action, Frank Spencer, alias "Crow," with the following crimes, to-wit: "Red-headed Mike," and "Joee James," with the following crimes and misdemeanors, to-wit: Grand Larceny, Petit Larceny, and Breach of Promise; that upon the day and date heretofore mentioned, he did with intent and malice, and against the dignity and peace of the Crown, steal, purloin, and covardly hide one silver watch, the property of Capt. Webber, of value unknown, consisting of Gold, Silver, and other precious stones, and jewelry, and the property of Mrs. Slick; and that he did with intent and malice, and against the dignity and peace of the Crown, steal, purloin, and covardly hide one silver watch, the property of Capt. The first fun was on the examination of the witness as to the defendant's character. This was conducted by the plaintiff's counsel, in your American police court style, and the British plaintiffs were amazed at the manner in which every witness was put on trial, and the main question utterly lost sight of and studiously ignored. Witness after witness was made to answer for a smiling jury, and the counsel instructed against them, and the defendant himself was examined the plaintiff's counsel showed him to be a deep-dyed villain, cunning, and red-headed murderer. At last the defendant's counsel had an opportunity to examine the fair plaintiff. She testified that Spencer had an ironed hair and a heavy beard before filing her, that she could only identify him, except for what? asserted the defendant's counsel.

"Except," she answered tearfully, "except that any woman so foolish as to give her name to a man who had a heavy beard before filing her, and who she did not get where she would identify him." "And young woman where might that be?"

showed of the year by welcoming to her hospitable the Triennial Convocation of the Knights Templar. These convocations have gradually increased in importance until they have passed into the rank of public festivals, independently of their special interest to their own members. Indeed, when it is considered that about fifty convocations are to take part in the San Francisco display; that four thousand Knights are to go from the East, thus swelling the numbers of those on the Pacific Coast to eight or ten thousand; that many of these Templars will be accompanied by their wives or children, and that visitors will throng to the show from all quarters, it is not surprising to learn that the local lodges expect to expend a hundred thousand dollars on the affair, and that the accommodations of the city will be strained to the utmost. Such well-known Commanderies as the Apollo of Boston, the Acacia of St. Louis, the Danvers of St. Paul, the Bayard of Indiana, the Columbia of Washington, and, in fact, Grand Commanderies from States as far east as Maine and as far south as Alabama, will send their representatives to this grand convocation. Inside the review, the procession, and the competitive drill, there will be excursions and other noteworthy entertainments. The street decorations are to be costly and abundant, and the five prizes or trophies for excellence in drill are of an intrinsic value far exceeding any before offered at these triennial gatherings. Looking at the many and successful pageants and shows of various sorts held by American cities during the past few years, it is not surprising that this lark for triennial gatherings, to which the people of the whole country are welcomed, steadily increases. Undoubtedly the great growth of the population, with an influx of Europeans who are accustomed to frequent festivals and holidays, has had an influence in this direction, while another important element in producing the result has been the extension of railroad facilities which enables a city to collect a vast number of visitors from all the regions about, and rapidly return them to their homes, without great cost of time or money to itself or its guests.—New York Sun.

The Kanai Robbery.

KANAI, July 11, 1888.
EVIDENCE—I see in your issue of to-day a notice of the robbery committed at my home on the 10th inst. The amount taken was \$157.50. I offered a reward of \$50 in addition to the \$50 offered by the Sheriff, and last night, the man suspected, Tam Fook, my old cook, was arrested in the swamp at the end of my garden, and on the Sheriff's suggestion, this morning, the following bills, a \$20 and a \$20 Treasury bill, were found carefully stitched in the hem of his linen vest and in the waistband of his trousers of \$150. His acknowledged having stolen the money, and further told the Sheriff to look it while we were at lunch in the dining room.

The public having been informed of the robbery, I thought best they should know of the capture and recovery of the stolen property, and also, to publicly acknowledge our obligation to the officers of the police. These are my reasons for troubling you and for impressing on your time and space.
