Funeral of the Late Vazir. George Augustus Sala, writing from St. Petersburg, thus describes the funeral of the Czar Alexander II:

I have just been a spectator of the most magnificent, most impressive and most pathetic pageant on which, in the course of a lengthened career accustomed to the pomp and vanities of royalty, I have been privileged to set eyes.

Three cannon, fired from the fortress, directed the various mourners to get ready to take their places. A similar salvo at about midday gave the signal to start, when a sable standard, bearing in white the initials of the murdered monarch, was unfurled over the altar.

Among the noticeable features was a figure which attracted much attention, the knight of golden armor mounted on a gorgeously harnessed steed, carrying a drawn sword, and supposed to symbolize the bright and spotless character of the departed sovereign.
