

Salvaged quonset tin and used oil drums constituted the major items furnished the outlying villages during the quarter. No gratuitous issues of food or clothing were made. School supplies and books, and needed medical supplies have been issued to each village as we were able to contact them during the quarter. See section B of this report for welfare activities at the leper colony. Having made our initial contact at this colony in the past month, definite plans are being formulated for future purposes built around a native supported operation.
