(4) Development and Expansion of Program, Results:

In July classwork was resumed on a five day week basis. The morning schedule includes ward round and instructions by the doctor. After duties are completed, the trainees are given a one hour lecture and demonstration on the various important phases of nursing technique. In the afternoon lectures in medicine for approximately an hour are given. We have been showing moving picture Hospital Training Films daily in conjunction with the classwork. The trainees respond well to this type of training. We interpret into Marshallese the dialogue as the picture progresses. Such important films as on isolation technique and field sanitation are shown and reshowed.

This period is followed by a one hour class in basic english held here in the hospital

classroom by one of the former Guam teacher trainees. Written examinations are given each Friday and a grade record book is being maintained.

The students are totated thru Surgical, Medical, Female, Laboratory and Sanitation services.

The text for classwork is the recently completed Manual for Marshallese Health Aides Trainees. A copy of the Manual will be forwarded to Guam soon.

Three Nurses Aides (Untrained) were sent to the Guam School of Nursing during this quarter. Three nominees for the June 1949 class of the Guam School of Medical Assistants have been entered in the District Intermediate School at Majuro.
