

(a) U.S. Naval Military Government Hospital #201, formerly located on Majuro (Laura) Island, has been moved to Uliga (Rosalie) Island, Majuro, Marshall Islands, location of the Naval Air Facilities and Military Government Headquarters. The Hospital is now in operation having utilized the NAF Dispensary and adjacent buildings. All necessary alterations and repairs have not been completed, but facilities are adequate for immediate needs and necessary work is continuing. Orders to decommission MG Hospital #201 and convert to a MG Dispensary were received on January 28 and this will be accomplished by February 3, 1947.

(b) Due to the recent move of MG Hospital #201 and pending further improvements the total bed capacity of the combined MG Hospital and NAF Dispensary is 50 beds, of which 40 are devoted to Native care.
