

(a) The main dispensary is located in Colonia. Seriously ill patients from all parts of this and other islands are hospitalized there.

(b) The CAU Dispensary consist of two wards of rough lumber construction, an operating room, and a ward for naval personnel and Dependents in a sixty-eight (68) foot quonset, and a bulk supply storehouse. Additional outbuildings include galley, mess, showers, heads, sanitation and laundry. Ward one used as a male ward, has thirteen regularly assigned beds and Ward two, (Women's) eighteen, with one bed each in three quiet rooms and two beds in another quiet room, all adjoining ward one. Bed capacity, however, is somewhat elastic since extra beds are set up on verandas as required. Facilities for bed patients have been expanded by the addition of canvas awnings and palm frond thatch on the veranda of ward one. A forty (40) foot extension on the quonset hut housing the O.R. and intended for inpatient accommodations for naval personeel and dependents is still being utilized for special investigations and mass treatments.
