

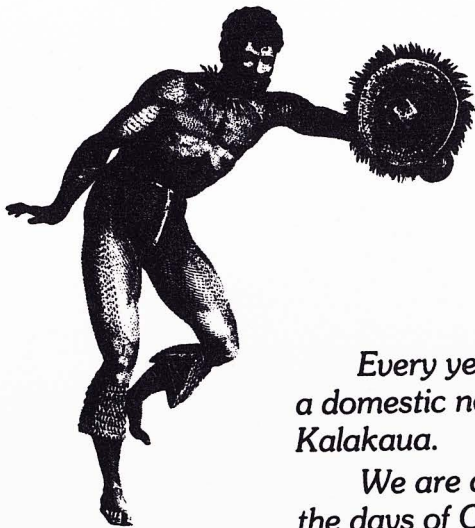

*To everyone who helps to make this festival a success, we humbly say mahalo a-nui-loa.*

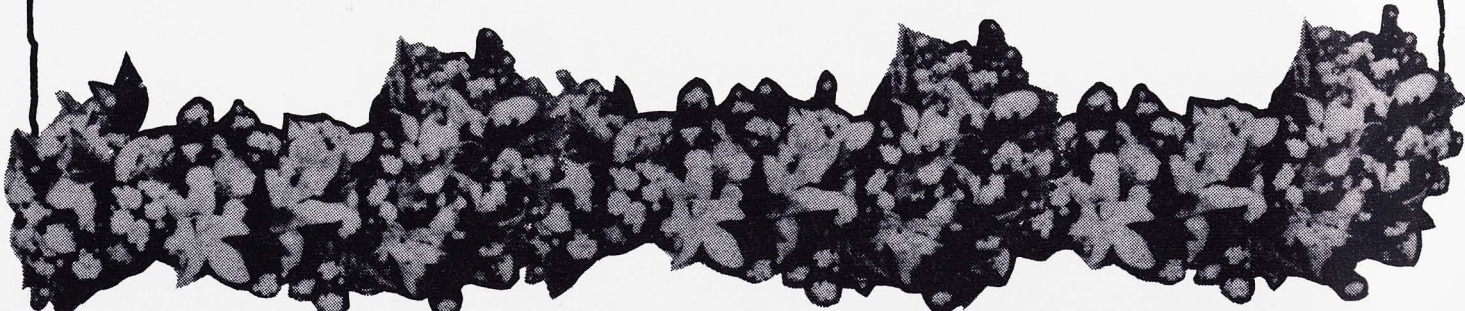
