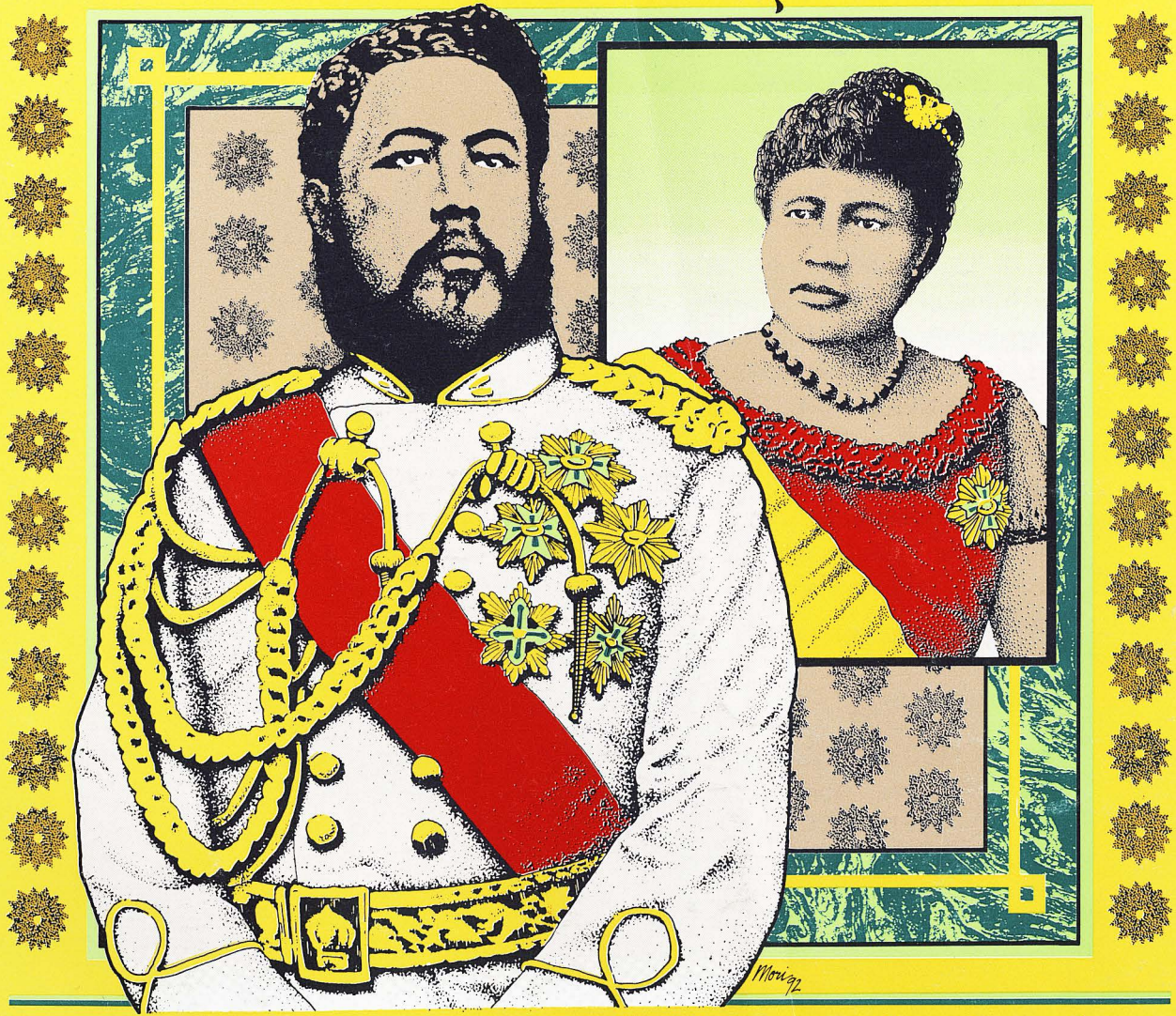

David Kalākaua was elected King of the Hawaiian Islands by the Legislative Assembly on February 12, 1874. His election followed the death of King William Lunalilo who died without naming a successor.

One of Kalākaua's first concerns was the establishment of a line of succession to the throne he now occupied, as his marriage was childless.

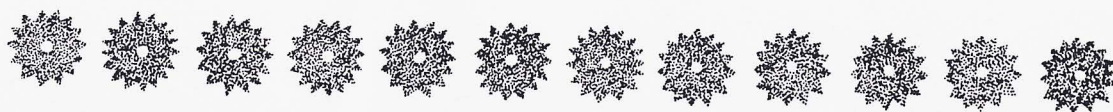
He appointed his brother, nineteen year old Prince Leleiohoku, as heir apparent.

Kalākaua's two sisters became princesses. Thirty-six year old Lydia Kamakaeha became Princess Lili'uokalani (in 1891 she acceded to the throne as Queen Lili'uokalani). She was married to John Owen Dominis (Governor of 'Oahu) and they had no children.

Thirty-one year old Miriam Auhea was named Princess Likelike. Her husband, Archibald Cleghorn, was a Scot and in 1875 their only child, Princess Kaiulani, was born.

King Kalākaua's wife, Queen Kapiolani was born of the highest ranking chiefs of Kaua'i. She was a granddaughter of King Kaumualii. Her three nephews were now designated Princes of Kalākaua's realm. David was named Prince Kawananakoa. Kuhio became Prince Kalaniana'ole and Edward's title was Prince Keliiohonui. Thus, King Kalākaua established an undisputed succession and legislative elections to the throne would be unnecessary in the future.

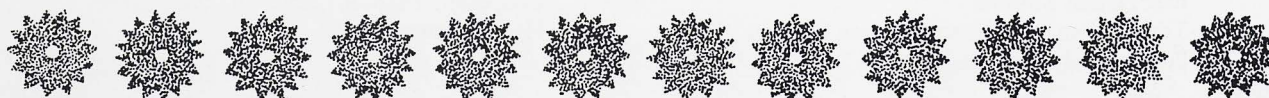

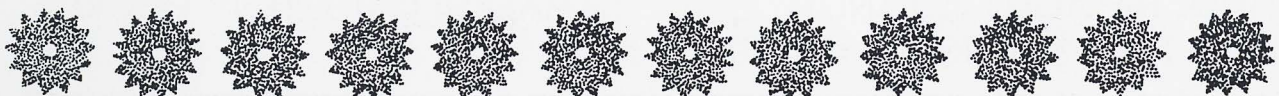

Aia Papaiki Kū Noho I Moloka'i .....(Men's Dance)  
*A dance that compares the warrior priest Papaiki as a great rooster in battle against the chief Kokokekalani of Maui.*  
Boki Kūmanomano .....(Women's Dance)  
*A religious dance honoring the dog guardian-protector of Kalaupapa.*  
Nuku'omakakalani .....(Men's Dance)  
*A dance of the Huaka'i Po (spirit night march) of the chief Nuku'omakakalani who broke the kapu and was doomed to roam the trails of Maunaloa at night.*  
Ka Makani Pū'ā'ā I Makanalua .....(Combined Group Dance)  
*A dance mentioning the four famous winds of Makanalua.*

## Grand Marshall

Helene Hale, Council member, representing the lower Puna District #5, was Chairman and Executive Officer of the County of Hawaii (forerunner of the present Mayor's position) in 1963-64.

It was under her administration that the idea of the Merrie Monarch Festival was conceived.



## Pa'u Queen

Pa'u Queen Elizabeth Napualani Napoleon (known to many as Napua) resides in Hilo. She is the mother of three children - Pili, Sarah and George Kahee and grandmother of ten. She was formerly disk jockey with KAHU Radio Station.

From an early age through her adult years, Napua was an accomplished hula dancer who performed locally, throughout the State of Hawaii and the mainland. For some years she depicted royal members within the Merrie Monarch Royal Court. Much of her hula and public experience was influential through her Uncle George Naope, a renowned hula master, entertainer and founder of the Merrie Monarch Festival.

As island Pa'u Princess, Napua has participated and competed in previous Kamehameha Day and Merrie Monarch parades held in Hilo and received commendable awards.

Her family history of cowboys exemplifies a profile of tradition passed on to four generations. Her grandfather, 'A'ola Ke, was a ranch hand at Ka'alu'alu Ranch and Kapapala Ranch. Her father, George Napoleon, Jr., former employee of Hawai'i National Park, was also a ranch hand for Ah Chun Lee Ranch in Kalapana. Her stepfather Joseph Ka'awaka Kailikini, was a rancher and her personal mentor. He taught Napua and her brother, George Napoleon, the skillful techniques and artistry of horsemanship. Her nephews, Cory and Jeremy Napoleon, and niece, Noelani Napoleon, are currently involved in competitive rodeos.

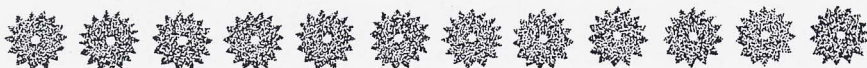

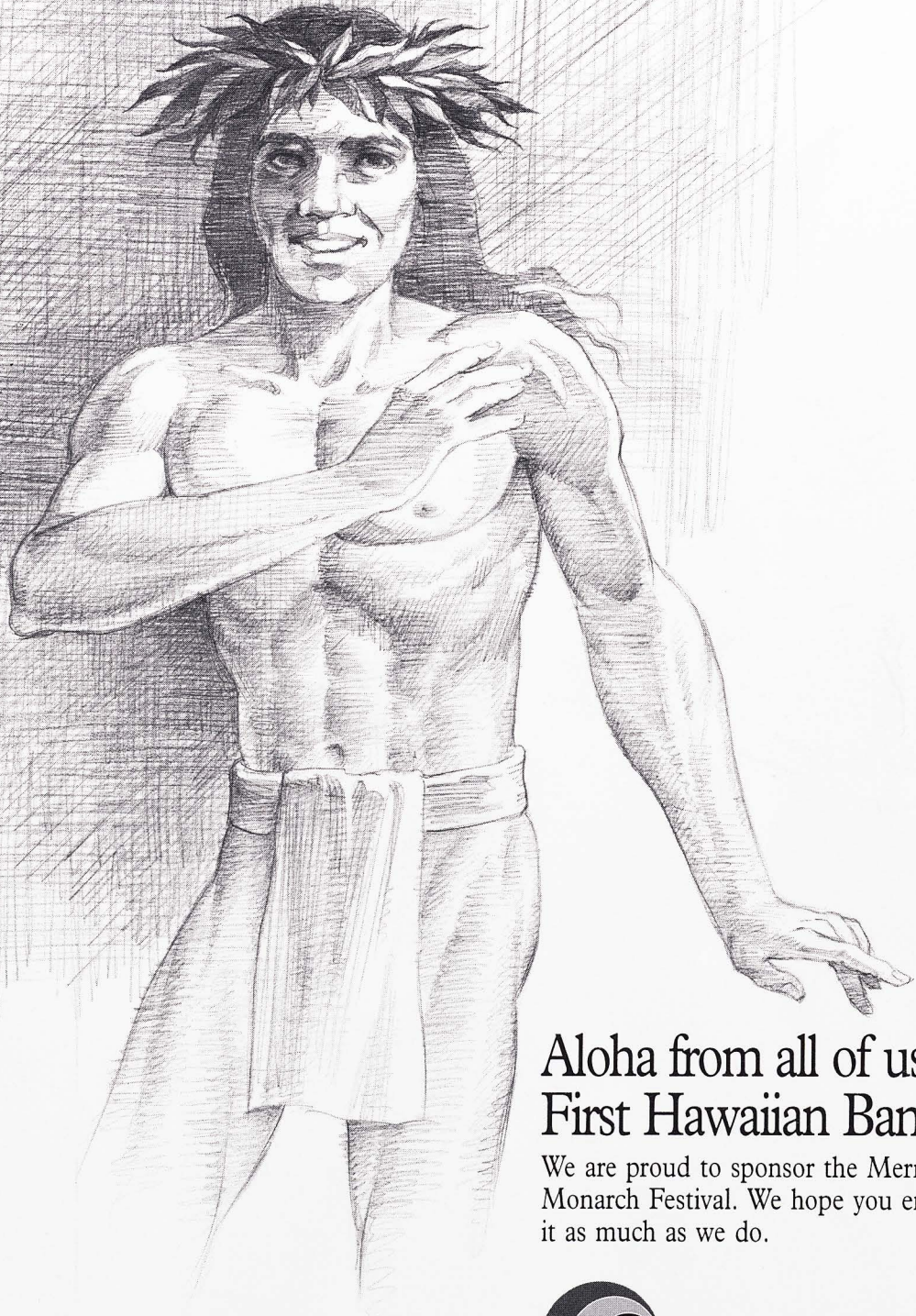
