

(a) Yaws: Few new cases of yaws were seen this quarter. Stress is on keeping the lesions bandaged at all times. The people are beginning to understand why this is necessary and cooperation is good.

(b) Gonococcus Infection: New cases were again noted in the labor camp at Kwajalein. Mass examinations were carried out and all cases found, treated. It is felt that there will be a decrease now that the Bikini people have departed to their new home island. Very few cases were noted in the field. Penicillin in oil (non-refrigerated type) is being left at all field stations and it is used by the Health Aide on all suspects. The use of this penicillin in the field is felt to be of great value in decreasing the incidence both of Yaws and Gonococcus Infection.
