

(a) Water chlorination has been sporadic and inadequate due to by-passing of chlorinator. Water pressure has dropped during the day since the new barracks went into operation and frequently dependents' housing and the dispensary were without water.

(b) Native Cemeteries: No change since last report.

(c) Pest Control: Continued weekly spraying with pack containers of CAU living areas, native heads in nearby villages and all known bomb craters, cisterns and stagnant pools. Since the crew has moved into the new barracks screens are painted weekly with DDT solution. Spraying by jeep was discontinued during the gasoline shortage and at present the spraying unit is under reconstruction. Loss of the jeep spray-rig was followed by a sharp increase in mosquito density in the CAU areas giving further evidence of the efficacy of this apparatus.

(d) Rodent Control: Rat poisoning campaigns have been undertaken at the following four areas: Old campsite, new barracks, dependents' housing I.T.C. food storage huts and dock. Total estimate of rats killed this quarter was six hundred twenty (620).

(e) Portable water supply: See Sanitation, subparagraph (a).
