

- (a) Field Inspections b U.S., Naval Personnel: The Sanitation Officer makes three to four unannounced inspections weekly of all Native villages, food dispensing establishments and farm areas.
- (b) Native Sanitations Inspectors:
1. No change, See previous report.
  2. Number being trained and where, rate of pay:  
None are being trained.
  3. Nature and degree of Supervision: The Sanitation Officer has supervision of the Sanitation Squad. See paragraph 5 above.
- (c) Native cemeteries:  
No change. See previous report.
- (d) Pest Control; measures taken and results:
- (1) Insects: Mosquitoes and flies remain numerous in all areas. Residual spraying with 5% DDT solution continues with all Military Government Areas being sprayed twice weekly.
  - (2) Rodents: No measures are in effect for the control of rodents other than trapping.  
A total of 2657 rats and 642 mice were trapped in all areas during this reporting period.
  - (3) Others:

(e) Potable Water Supply: All water is received from central island water supply.
