

The health of the Native population has been very good during the period covered by this report.

Sanitary conditions of all Military Government Areas have been entirely satisfactory insofar as the present limited personnel and equipment has permitted. Due to construction of new houses, opening of new business establishments and the increasing farm areas now under control of the Military Government, the number of personnel assigned to sanitation and the equipment furnished is considered wholly inadequate.

In order to better meet the sanitary requirements of the native villages and other Military Government areas the following is recommended:

- (a) The number of personnel assigned to the sanitary squad be increased by 5 men.
- (b) One  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ton truck be assigned to Sanitation for hauling trash and garbage.
- (c) One weapons carrier or similar vehicle be equipped with power spraying equipment so that areas requiring DDT spray may be covered more often and with better results.
