

Health of the Native population has been generally good. However, Tuberculosis and intestinal parasites remain a major health problem. One hundred and thirt one (131) sputum negative cases of Pulmonary Tuberculosis remain at large in the villages due to lack of facilities for active treatment and hospitalization.

A total of four hundred (400) patients remain to be X-rayed which will complete the annual chest X-ray survey program in approximately six weeks.

Twelve (12 to fifteen (15) stool specimens are examined daily in the village clinic and the dispensary laboratory. Treatment is administered according to laboratory findings.

Recommendations: None.
