(3) The increase in the number of new cases of Yaws is felt to be the result of the finding and bringing in of these cases by the native orderlies assigned to the outlying islands within the Truk atoll. Because of this increase some patients were admitted to the Dispensary and treated with 1,000,000 units of Penicillin. Comparative treatments are under investigation to check the Yaws program operating outside the Truk

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atoll. A more rigid check is being made on patients reporting for Mapharsen and Bismuth treatments. It is obvious now that the eradication of Yaws within the Truk Atoll has not been as complete as previously estimated.

(4) Classroom lectures are given daily by Medical Department

personnel from 1500 to 1630 except Friday, when a film depicting some phase of hospital or sanitation work is shown. All classroom work is mimeographed in English and Trukese. Practical instruction and demonstration is given by Medical Department personnel on the wards, dressing room, operating room and sick call room.
