I an writing this letter to you since I heard that you are the s me person who worked with us in the Medford Civilian Conservation Corps District, Orejon under Colonel Fletcher and Colonel Paul A. Veiland. I wish to Q ask fovor of you after I have given you my military background and my brief life history since I know yo are very much interested in t e problems of the Japanese Avericans.

I was born in Honolulu, Hawaii on February 20,1900 of Japanese parents, who left me in Pewaii to be brought up in the American Way of Life when I was about 13 years of age. 6 I was given four years of high school R.O.T.C.followed by three wears of university H.O.T.C., together with training in three summer R.O.T.J. c mps.I received the Infactry Reserve Commission through the U iversity of Mehraska, Lincoln Mehraska in Ju e, 1999. I was to asferred to the Medical Reserves in 1955 and was commissioned Contain, Medical Reserves while on active duty with the CCC on June 23,1939.As you know, I served in the CCC from 1a- 1936 to Pebruary, 1942 as camp surject and assistant District Sur con.Bolonel Paul A. Veiland nd Colonel CC.McCornach, Peneral Staff Corns 'estern Defense Cor and have recommended me highly as to my work in the C.C.C. My record will show that my work hes been of a superior a ality.

At the time of the most evacuation of the people of Japarese encestry, I was movel to the lengt lourtain Relea tion Center with others and there I servel as a norber of the RAL parital Stiff, Ch irrem of U.S.C. Executive Corritore, Character Legation for Scout Council, Nerber of the Journities for the Prevention of Juvenile Delinmence, and re ber of the Bo ri of Directors of M.N.O.A. I was called to sotive 1 to on Larch 1,1945(inte of rubi: Feb 2,1945).I was sent to the Medical Replacement, Pool, C ruisle Barrachs, Penn-sylvania. I attended the 24th Officer's Tefresher Dourse, the Alvanced Fool Course, allowe jist correlated the 7th Fedical Instector's Course at this School. The Commandant has repeatedly colled Washington for my assignment but although of ers of Jaronese descent are being assignment, I bare not been fortunate.
