- (a) The distribution of salvaged dunnage, lumber, corrugated iron, discarded oil drums, cement and paint was continued on all field trips.
- (b) (c). The above material was specified for schools and churches. Discarded desks from the Army and old benches were also distributed to all islands visited for the schools.
- (d) Repairs to meeting houses, using native materials, was stressed at all council meetings if conditions warranted. Cement was provided where community water catchments needed repairing.
