## Supreme Court of the Hawaiian Islands.

JANUARY TERM, 1871.—IN BANCO.  
ALLEN, C. J., BARTWELL AND WIDMANN, J. J.  
In the matter of the Estate of Moku, (K.) of  
Koolanipo, deceased.  
This matter came up on petition filed by  
Mahu, the duly appointed Administrator of said  
Estate, before Justice Widmann, praying that a  
day and an hour may be appointed for the pre-  
sentation of his accounts, and that he be dis-  
charged from the responsibilities of the adminis-  
tration aforesaid. Order was thereupon issued  
on the 13th of April, 1870, fixing the 19th day  
of May, for the hearing of this petition, in the  
Court House at Honolulu, and giving notice to  
all interested in said Estate to appear and  
show cause, if any they have, why the said  
accounts should not be passed, and the said  
Administrator be discharged from all further re-  
sponsibility in this matter. Notice of this to be  
given in the Ka Ika Oka Newspaper for three  
weeks previous to said hearing.  
Nahua, (w.) appeared as contestant.  
The evidence of the witness Kuliapahu, (w.)  
on behalf of the contestant, Nahua, is that  
Kahuna (K.) and Nahua (w.) were the grand-  
parents of Moku, deceased, and Nahua, (w.)  
contestant; that they had two daughters, Kapo,  
the mother of Nahua, and Nawaupukana, the  
mother of Moku, deceased; that witness knew  
Kahuna and Nahua, and that she knew  
these two daughters—Kapo and Nawaupukana—  
were born; that Kahuna and Nahua had no  
other children, that witness knew them well;  
that she lived with them at Kua. The evidence  
of the witness Kuliapahu, (w.) also for contestant  
Nahua, shows exactly the same relationship, and  
further that Kahuna and Nahua had a son  
after Nawaupukana, the second daughter. The  
witness Kuliapahu (w.) only states that Moku,  
deceased, was in the habit of calling Nahua  
"Kaikawahine."

The witness Hapua, (K.) for the Adminis-  
trator, states that witness has lived all his life  
at Kua and knew Mahua living with his  
mother Kawaupukana at Kua from childhood.  
Olikahekeheke (K.) and Kahuna (w.) had three  
daughters: Kawaupukana, the mother of Mahua;  
Pukaana and Opanui.  
The evidence of Kuli, for the Administrator,  
is that Olikahekeheke and Kahuna (whom  
witness did not personally know) had three  
daughters, Kawaupukana, Pukaana and Opanui,  
and one son, Kawa. All these four lived in  
Koolan, and Opanui afterwards went to live at  
Mokuia. That Kawaupukana was the mother  
of Mahua; Pukaana, the mother of Moku, de-  
ceased, and Opanui, the mother of Uka.  
It appears further from the evidence given  
by the same witness, Kuli, at the hearing of the  
petition for the granting of letters of administra-  
tion on the Estate of Moku, deceased, to Ma-  
hu, the petitioner, that Uka, the son of Opanui,  
and cousin of Mahua, was present in court.

The Court, after weighing the evidence, ordered  
that Mahua be entitled to the remainder of the  
property.

No further evidence was produced, and the  
case was submitted without argument.

OPINION OF THE COURT, BY BARTWELL, J.  
Appeal from the decision of Mr. Justice Wide-  
mann in refusing to order Mahua, Administrator  
of the estate of Moku, deceased, on hearing for  
allowance of his administration accounts and dis-  
charge as Administrator, to pay over the property  
remaining in his hands to the appellant, Nahua,  
claiming to be entitled thereto as heir.</
