1. A MEETING OF THE COMMUNITY RELATIONS COUNCIL (CRC) CONVENED  
AT 1300, 3 JAN 85. THE MEETING WAS HELD IN THE OFFICE OF THE  
KWAJALEIN ATOLL LOCAL GOVERNMENT (KALG), EBeye, MARSHALL ISLANDS.

2. MR. KABUA AND ACTING MAYOR BOLKIEM WELCOMED COL SPIN AND HIS  
STAFF TO EBeye. COL SPIN THANKED THEM FOR THE OPPORTUNITY TO HOLD  
THE MEETING THERE. ACTING MAYOR BOLKIEM INFORMED THE COUNCIL THAT  
MAYOR JACKLICK HAD LEFT NO NEW BUSINESS TO BE DISCUSSED AT THE  
MEETING.  
3. MINUTES OF THE 6 DEC 84 MEETING WERE REVIEWED. PARAGRAPH 4D  
WAS AMENDED TO INCLUDE MAYOR JACKLICK'S EXPRESSION OF THANKS FOR  
COL SPIN'S EFFORTS IN IMPLEMENTING IMPROVED WATER DELIVERY  
PROCEDURES. MINUTES APPROVED.  
4. OLD BUSINESS:  
A. MIDWIFE TRAINING PROGRAM. COL SPIN COMPLIMENTED MR. KABUA AND  
RMI ON THEIR SWIFT ATTENTION IN GETTING THE PROGRAM STARTED. THREE  
INDIVIDUALS HAVE ALREADY BEEN TRAINED, TWO AT EBeye AND ONE FROM  
ENNUBIRR. THIS WILL BE AN ON-GOING PROGRAM AND SHOWS A VERY  
POSITIVE RESPONSE TOWARD HAVING TRAINED PEOPLE IN ALL POPULATED  
AREAS OF THE ATOLL. MR. KABUA STATED THIS PROGRAM WOULD CONTINUE  
TO RECEIVE HIS ATTENTION AND THAT CARLOS AND EBADON WOULD NOT BE  
OVERLOOKED.  
B. REPAIR OF EBeye PIER: COL SPIN COMMENDED THE EFFORTS OF EBeye  
PUBLIC WORKS IN INSTALLING ADDITIONAL FENDERING AND REPAIRING THE

STEPS AT THE PASSENGER LOADING AREA. HOWEVER, ONLY ONE OF THE LIGHTS ON THE PIER IS WORKING. COL SPIN EXPRESSED HIS CONCERN ABOUT THE POOR VISIBILITY AT NIGHT AND REQUESTED MRGM KABUA'S IMMEDIATE ASSISTANCE TO GET THE LIGHTS ON THE DOCK REPAIRED BEFORE AN ACCIDENT OCCURS. MR. KABUA STATED THE PROBLEM WAS BEING WORKED ON AND THE LIGHTS WOULD BE REPAIRED VERY SOON.

C. WATER DELIVERIES TO EBEEYE. COL SPIN ASKED IF THERE WERE ANY PROBLEMS. MR. KABUA STATED THERE WERE NO PROBLEMS, AND AT THIS TIME THE WATER SYSTEM CANNOT HANDLE MORE THAN TWO BARGES PER WEEK.

D. SAFETY OF CHILDREN IN THE TERMINAL AREA. COL SPIN REEMPHASIZED KMR'S CONCERN ON THIS MATTER. CHILDREN ARE STILL SEEN RUNNING THROUGH AND PLAYING IN THE PARKING LOT AND BAGGAGE HANDLING AREA. HE REQUESTED THAT MR. KABUA AGAIN STRESS THE IMPORTANCE OF THE PARENT OR GUARDIANS KEEPING THE CHILDREN IN THE WAITING AREA TO AVOID THE UNNECESSARY RISK. MR. KABUA AGREED TO ASSIST IN SOLVING THIS PROBLEM.

E. ENNUBIRR POSTAL SERVICE. GENERAL DISCUSSION ON THIS ISSUE REGARDING COMMENTS IN THE 6 DEC 84 CRC MEETING. COL SPIN SUGGESTED A BRANCH OF THE EBEEYE POST OFFICE BE ESTABLISHED OR SERVICE BE PROVIDED ONE OR TWO DAYS A WEEK WITH AN RMI POSTAL EMPLOYEE FROM

EBEEYE GOING THERE TO CONDUCT BUSINESS. MR. KABUA STATED THIS WOULD BE CONSIDERED.

5. NEW BUSINESS:

A. FERRY SCHEDULE CHANGE. COL SPIN EXPLAINED THE CHANGES MADE RECENTLY TO THE FERRY SCHEDULE EMPHASIZING THE MORE EFFICIENT UTILIZATION OF MARINE ASSETS WHILE STILL PROVIDING NECESSARY TRANSPORTATION FOR BADGED EMPLOYEES AND OTHER TRAVELERS ON A SPACE AVAILABLE BASIS. MR. KABUA STATED HE HAD OBSERVED SEVERAL AREAS OF THE KMR OPERATION WHERE MORE ECONOMICAL AND BETTER UTILIZATION OF ASSETS WERE BEING STRESSED, AND HE LOOKED ON THESE WITH INTEREST FOR POSSIBLE UTILIZATION IN LOCAL RMI OPERATIONS.

B. EMERGENCY MEDICAL EVACUATIONS. COL SPIN DISCUSSED RECENT MEDICAL EVACUATION EFFORTS AT CARLOS AND EBADON. HE STRESSED THE NEED FOR RMI INVOLVEMENT IN THESE TYPE EFFORTS, I.E., MEDICAL PERSONNEL, RMI CONSTABLES, OR OTHER RMI PRESENCE AS NECESSARY. MR. KABUA ENSURED HE WAS AWARE OF THIS NEED AND WOULD MAKE EVERY ATTEMPT TO BETTER COORDINATE THESE EFFORTS WHEN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS ARISE IN THE FUTURE.

6. THE NEXT MEETING IS SCHEDULED FOR 1300, 7 FEB 85, AT THE KMR TERMINAL BUILDING, CONFERENCE ROOM.
