The result of the interview was that Wing entered his service, and was made a Mandarin of the fifth rank, there being nine degrees of that dignity in the Chinese official system. At this time the great Taiping rebellion was at its height, and Tsang Kok Fan was in the field. In fact, the interview had taken place at his camp in Nanking, on the Yang Tze river. The Viceroy first tendered Wing a military command, which, on the score of lack of qualification, he declined to accept.
