While moving forward for an attack he was hit by mortar shell fragments and died instantly. I saw him shortly thereafter since the medics and I were in that vicinity. He was given a proper burial in an American Cometery in Northern Italy; later on the cuartermaster coneral (washington, D. C.) will inform you of the exact location of his grave. And his personal belongings will come to you through army channels.
