JANUARY 16TH, 1893. GATHERING AT THE ARMOY A YEAR AGO TO-DAY.

Safety Committee's Report—Declaration of Independence—Speeches that were Made.

A year ago to-day the big mass meeting was held in the Armory. Nearly 1500 citizens responded to the call of the Committee of Safety.

Hon. W. C. Wilder was chairman. He said he took the post as a duty, not as an honor.

Hon. Lorrin A. Thurston rose to read the report of the Committee of Safety.

Mr. Thurston went to utter words that would be heard around the world.

The suppressed excitement was nerve-tiring and thrilling. In clear, bold tones the committee members presented a statement of the accumulated grievances.

There were recounted the famous juggery of the Legislature, the almost incredible maneuvering in connection with the attempt to foist an oppressive constitution upon the people.

Mr. H. F. Glade began: "The Queen has done an unexcusable and unpardonable thing in her attempt to alter the constitution which she had sworn to uphold."

Mr. A. Young, who on the same platform had made the speech that turned the day into a historic one.

Mr. C. Rolfe called attention to the vacillating and highly menacing conduct of the ruler.

Hon. H. P. Baldwin characterized the Queen's action as revolutionary.

Mr. John Emmelhut had heard the charged and angered Queen's speech at the palace and had noted that the expression upon her face was fenshish.

Mr. R. J. Green said: "Our patience has been exhausted. We all agree about this case. The question is the remedy."

There had been applause throughout the speech-making. The resolutions were adopted by a unanimous standing vote.

Two hundred lanterns will be used about the incandescent lights near the speakers' stand.

The Annexation Club headquarters will decorate and the military proposes to do something worth while in the same line.
