Geography - ^{Ula} Ruk - Beautiful high island 15 miles in circumference where mission is located. Altogether there are about 20 high islands in this group.

Mortlock - consists of 3 atolls + 1 islet.
 language is Tokunori.

Products - Limited in variety though abundant.

Manufacture -

Mortlock - Good cord + rope from coconut husk.
 Cloth from Hibiscus fibres.

Dress - Native dress is a loin cloth for men, and a short skirt for the women.

13th voyaged morning star. Sailed on the 27th. ~~Russia~~
first round of her course is to Butaritari, Russia,
Pungelap, Mokit, Pongu, Ngatic, + Uuk. From
a direct return will be made to Russia. The next
round will be a tour of the Marshalls.
