



In compliance with Proclamation issued 8 February 1943 by Lt. General Delos C. Emmons, USA, Military Governor of Hawaii, the enclosed list of companies and agencies will remain under regulation by General Orders of the Military Governor after 10 March 1943. You will be promptly notified of additions to or deletions from this list.

This information is furnished to enable you to guard against violation of Orders of the Military Governor by hiring employees of the firms and agencies herein listed unless they present clear releases.

- d. Employees of public utilities.

Brief Summary of Activities
Carried on by Firms and Agencies subject
to General Orders No. 10

American Stevedoring Company:

Contract with Supply Officer, 14th Naval District, for stevedoring activities on ships carrying naval cargo.

Black, E. E. Limited:

Construction contractor to Navy Department, engaged in work on ammunition dumps and depots.

Black, Glover & Woolley:

Construction contractors to Navy Department, engaged in work on ammunition dumps and depots.

Board of Labor Employment:

Maintenance, repair and construction work at Navy Yard, Pearl Harbor.

Castle & Cooke Terminals, Ltd.:

Contracts for stevedoring work with Army, Navy and the War Shipping Administration.

Commercial Pacific Cable Company:

Trans-Pacific cable service.

Contractors, Pacific Naval Air Bases:

Construction contractors to District Public Works Officer, 14th Naval District; building of underground fuel storage, underground ammunition storage, and all naval air bases in South Pacific.

Corps of Engineers:

Engaged in construction activities of all nature to conform with Army requirements in South Pacific.

Page 3Consolidated Contractors:

Construction contractors to Army in erection of cold storage plants.

Department Medical, Ordnance, Post Exchange, Quartermaster, and Signal Offices, Ft. Shafter:

Engaged in activities accruing to them as members of Hawaiian Service Forces.

Federal Transportation Company:

Supplier of bus transportation between Honolulu and North Sector, Island of Oahu.

Globe Wireless, Limited:

Trans-Pacific wireless service.

Glover, James W.:

Construction contractor to Army and Navy; also engaged in building military roads.

Hawaiian Air Depot:

Servicing, repair and maintenance of Army aircraft.

Hawaiian Air Lines, Limited:

Commercial air lines between islands of the Hawaiian Group.

Hawaiian Bitumuls Company:

Engaged in bituminous surfacing of air fields on all islands in Hawaiian Group under Army and Navy contracts.

Hawaiian Constructors:

Formerly chief construction contractors to Army; work has been and is being absorbed by Corps of Engineers.

Hawaiian Dredging Company:

Dredging contract, and repair contract for dredging machinery with the Navy.

Hawaiian Electric Company, Ltd.:

Prime supplier of electrical current, Island of Oahu.

Hawaiian Tuna Packers, Shipyards Division:

Ship repair facilities, small naval craft, PT-boats and barges.

Honolulu Gas Company, Ltd.:

Prime supplier of gas, City of Honolulu.

Honolulu Rapid Transit Company, Ltd.:

Operators of public transportation system in the City of Honolulu and some outlying districts.

Hooehuli Bus Company:

Transportation facilities between Honolulu and Nanakuli District.

Inter-Island Steam Navigation Co., Ltd.:

Dock facilities and ship repairs for small naval craft, PT-boats and barges.

Island Transport Company:

Bus service between Honolulu, Schofield Barracks and Kaneohe Naval Air Station.

Koolau Transport Service:

Transportation service between Honolulu and Schofield Barracks.

Mackay Radio & Telegraph Company:

Trans-Pacific radio service.

McCabe, Hamilton & Renny:

Contracts for stevedoring work with Army, Navy and the War Shipping Administration.

Mutual Telephone Company, Ltd.:

Supplier of entire telephone services on all islands in the Hawaiian Group.

Page 5Oahu Railway & Land Company:

Operating only railway on Island of Oahu for the movement of Army and Navy freight.

Pacific Bridge Company:

Construction of dry docks, Navy Yard, Pearl Harbor.

Pan-American Airways:

Trans-Pacific air transport company.

Pearl Harbor Drivers' Association:

Taxi and bus service between Honolulu and Pearl Harbor, Navy Yard.

Permanente Corporation, The:

Stevedoring activities in connection with unloading of cement brought on their own ships and under contract to the Navy.

Pacific Construction Company, Ltd.:

Army contract for erection of cold storage plant; Navy contract for construction and repair of heavy barges.

R.C.A. Communications, Inc.:

Trans-Pacific radio service.

Ship's Service Office, 14th Naval District:

Similar in scope of work carried on by Department Post Exchange Office in the operation of ship service stores, Hawaiian Group.

Standard Dredging Corporation:

Dredging contract, U. S. Navy.

Wahiawa Transport Service:

Bus service between Honolulu and Schofield Barracks.

Windward Transit, Limited:

Bus service between Honolulu and Army and Navy posts on windward Oahu.

Dock facilities and tug boat contracts with Army, Navy and the War Shipping Administration.
