Dear Mother:

My heart goes out in sympathy for you in the loss of your son Chuji. May our heavenly Father bless you with His comfort in your hours of grief.

Your son was taken to the hospital and given the very best attention possible. Friends who were present in the same hospital told me of the constant watch the physicians kept over him. But these efforts were fruitless. However Chuji was not aware of his suffering since he was unconscious almost all the time.

He was given a decent Christian burial, and in due course of time the Quartermaster General, Washington, D. C., will inform you of the location of his grave. Also his personal things will be sent later on by this same Department.
