Dear Mr. McCloy:

I wrote you on November 29, 1943, acknowledging receipt of a tentative revision of the "Standard Operating Procedure for Military Police at Tule Lake Center" dated 15 October 1943, and indicating that, since further consideration of the Standard Operating Procedure was in progress, I would delay further reply to your letter of November 3 until later. Since then a new draft of the Standard Operating Procedure has been issued under date of 6 December 1943, and a Memorandum of Agreement has been entered into between the Commanding General, Ninth Service Command, and the War Relocation Authority. Copies of these instruments have been sent to us by Mr. Robert B. Cozzens, Assistant Director of the War Relocation Authority at San Francisco, who has been dealing with Gen. D. M. McCoach, Jr., on these matters.

I am today writing a letter to Mr. Cozzens in reference to the two documents which he has submitted to this office. A copy of that letter is enclosed. If you wish to make any comments or offer any suggestions in connection with either of the documents, I shall be pleased to receive them.
