CITIZENS of Hawaii able to attend will miss much if they fail to hear the lecture by the Chief Justice at the Y. M. C. A. this evening. He will talk of the foundations of law here, and the layman can store more information by listening an hour than he could by studying many months.

While the Y. M. C. A. loses a most valuable man in the retirement of D. W. Corbett, who enters business life, it is the intention of the managers of the institution to provide capable succession to the man who built the Society to its present strong condition of usefulness.

HONOLULU now has better systems of roads and water supply than ever before in her history and in these particulars is far in advance of nine out of ten places of the same size in other countries. There are also parks, a museum, electric lights, horse street railway with prospects of electric city transit, telephone service, paid fire department, good schools and colleges.

REPORTS of success in co-operative cane culture and of the permanent settlement of men of limited means on small holdings in various Islands warrant anew the assurance to farmers abroad that a full measure of reward will attend their immigration to these fertile islands, where more can be produced with less outlay than in any section of the globe now open to the pioneer.

A VERY large amount of literature relating to the Volcano of Kilauea, now active, goes forward by the steamer today. E. C. Macfarlane and C. D. Chase, of the Volcano House Company, have been about as active in arranging for advertisement of Pele's domain and Hawaii in general at this time as the heaving fires of Halemau-manu. These gentlemen are doing the country a signal service by judiciously and aggressively striving to attract tourists.

THE new commonwealth of Utah, in the American Union, starts out with a constitution differing in several important points from those of other States. For instance, it provides that juries shall consist of eight men instead of twelve, and that in civil cases three-fourths of the number may render a verdict. Another provision is to the effect that the State shall never go into debt exceeding \$200,000, except in case of insurrection; and another guarantees to every citizen the right to obtain employment whenever possible, and makes any interference with this right a crime. Women are granted equal suffrage in the new State.

THE apparent new growth and activity in banana and pineapple culture, which has been a notable feature of the past two or three years, is as an actual fact simply a revival in these lines. Several times before these particular industrial proportions have been reached. The relapses have always been for the same reasons. Discouragements have been the erratic steamer service and the high carrier rates. The Government could well afford to come to the rescue of the industry. This could be done by securing, with a guarantee, favorable terms and arrangements with the steamer companies. A substantial backing would give such an impetus to fruit growing that any reasonable guarantee would be certain to be fully made up.

Timely Topics.

The last mail brought good news for the people of these islands. It is stated that there will be no grinding of sugar cane in Cuba this year, owing to the rebellion, and consequently the world's supply will be decreased by 1,000,000 tons, one-fifth of the entire production of the world. A considerable increase in prices is therefore certain. On top of this comes the information that Senator Perkins is making a strong fight to secure a higher tariff on sugar, as he wished to encourage the beet sugar planters of California. Senator Perkins believes that where the Republicans can secure control of the Senate protection will be granted by bounty or increase of duty. The San Francisco Bulletin in commenting on the proposition says: "Senator Perkins has introduced a resolution instructing the Finance Committee to report an amendment to the revenue bill increasing the duty on raw sugar. He will support the resolution with a speech intended to enlighten the Senators as to the value of the beet-sugar industry. The beet-sugar industry is in line with the iron and steel industry, the woolen industry and the manufacture of tin plates. Sugar can easily be produced in the United States in quantities sufficient to supply the home demand, but the cost of production in this country is greater than in countries from which we import sugar. It is just a question whether the government shall impose duties on foreign sugar equal to the difference in the cost of production or whether we shall continue to buy our sugar abroad. This is a branch of industry in which farmers may be directly protected. So long as we export wheat we can extend to the farmer only indirect protection. But if we place a duty on sugar the producer is protected to the full amount of the duty. Farmers who find it difficult to make the two ends meet in producing wheat at present prices may make a good profit in producing sugar if the duty is raised to about 1 cent a pound." If the duty mentioned, is placed on sugar, Hawaii will be just that much ahead as our product will go in free under the terms of the Reciprocity Treaty.
