The color of the lining of the hood designates the university or college by which the degree was granted; for example — crimson, Harvard; blue, Yale; red and blue, Pennsylvania; blue and gold, California; purple and gold, Washington; light blue and white, Columbia; maroon, Chicago; maroon and gold, Minnesota; cardinal and white, Wisconsin; cardinal, Stanford; old gold and sable, Johns Hopkins; scarlet and gray, Ohio State; maize and blue, Michigan; green and white, Hawaii.
