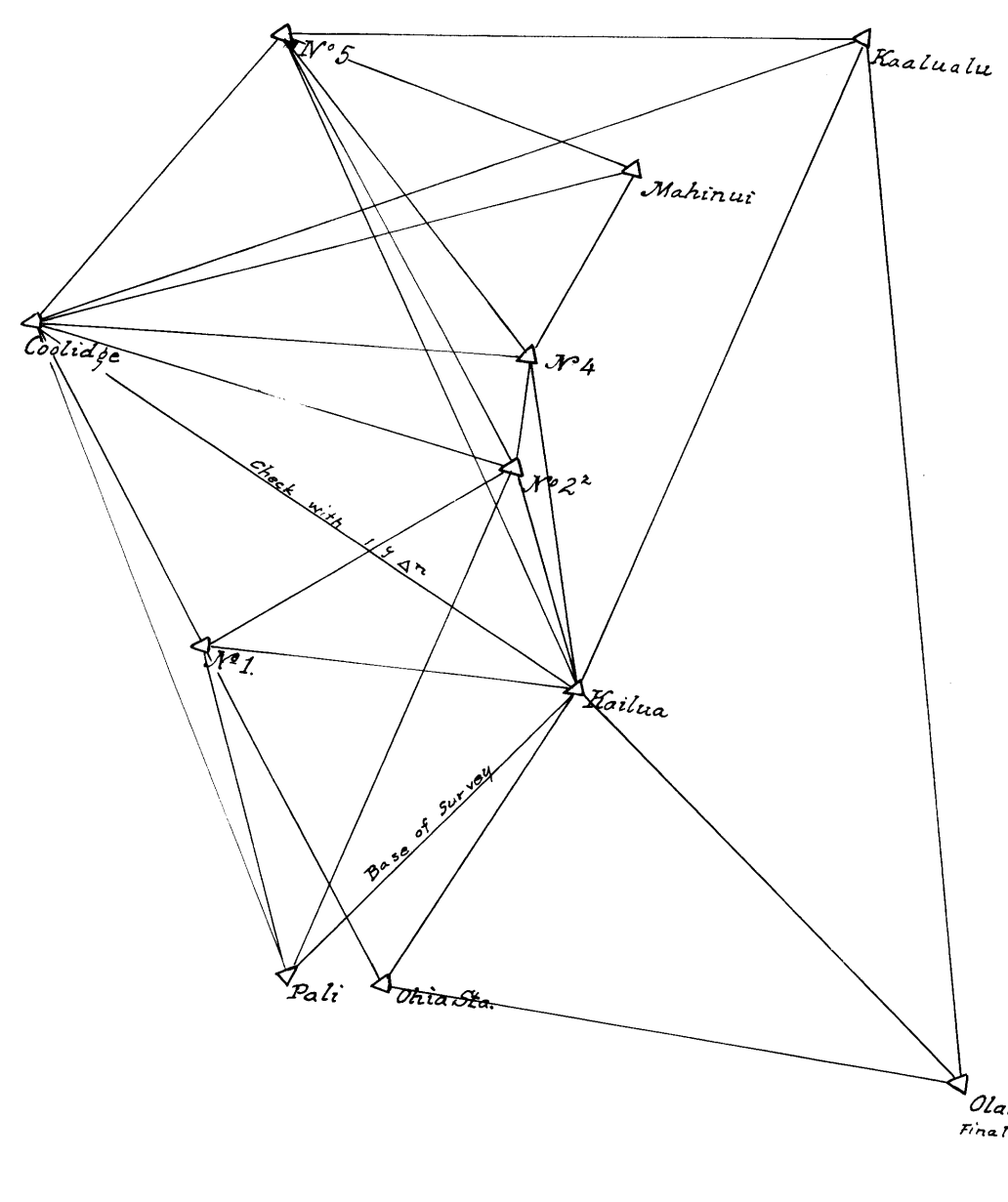


OAHU, With WEST KAILUA

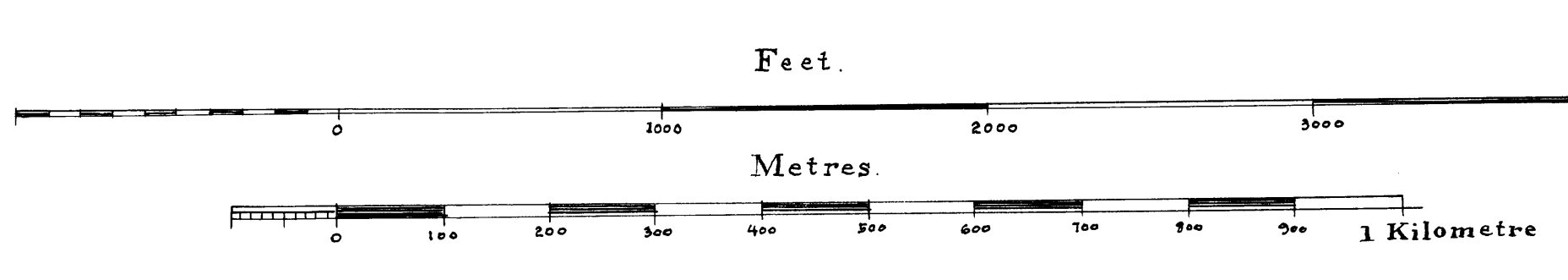
