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district. In this way it will be possible to bring the health aides from all the sub-dispensaries into the main dispensary for a period of from two to four months a year and still insure the staffing of their sub-dispensaries with health aides from their own islands, thus not interrupting the working efficiency of the sub-dispensary. In some cases where the island population does not warrant having two health aides, a group of trained health aides will be available for temporary duty at the sub-dispensary of such an island while the health aide of that island returns to the main dispensary for his refresher work and further instruction. Such a program of rotation should provide for continued improvement in the work of the health aides throughout the Truk district and permit the efficient operation of the main dispensary without the duplication of men permanently assigned and men under training.
