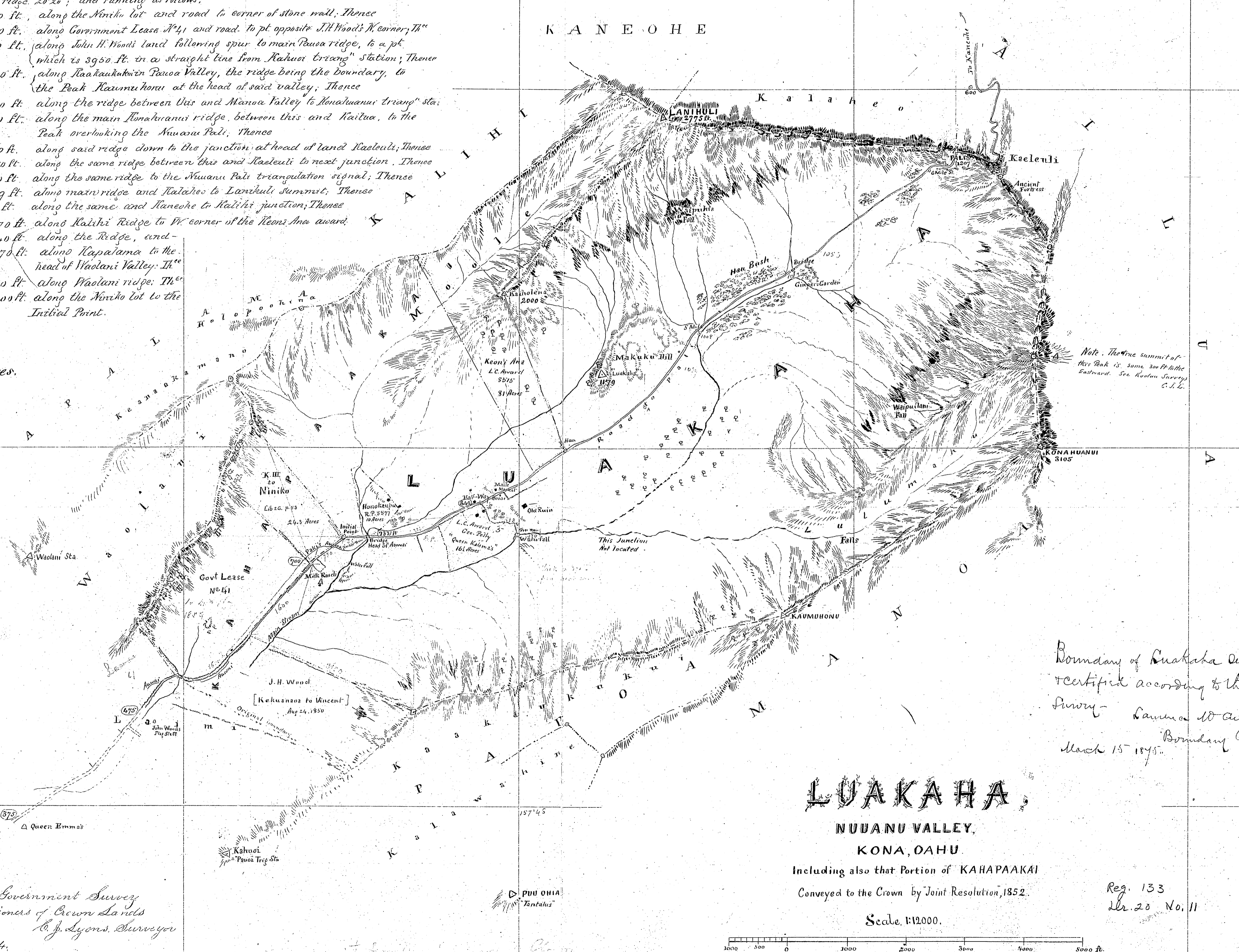


**Description**

Beginning at a point by the main road, 350 ft. S 80° W, true, from the West corner of the large Luakaha Bridge, said point being the East corner of the Niniko property, from which point moreover the following are azimuth bearings by the true meridian governing this survey, viz: Konaananui triang. station 262° 35'; Konaananui peak nearest Pali 235° 20'; Kahuoi point on Pauoa ridge 20° 20'; and running as follows:

- I. S. 51° 00' W. true 730 ft. along the Niniko lot and road to corner of stone wall; Thence
- II. S. 41° 10' W. " 1600 ft. along Government Lease No. 41, and road to pt. opposite J.H. Wood's N. corner; Thence
- III. S. 65° 30' E. " 3100 ft. along John H. Wood's land following spur to main Pauoa ridge, to a pt. which is 3950 ft. in a straight line from Kahuoi triang. station; Thence
- IV. N. 75° 00' E. " 6500 ft. along Kaakaukui in Pauoa Valley, the ridge being the boundary, to the Peak Kaumuhonu at the head of said valley; Thence
- V. N. 56° 40' E. " 5200 ft. along the ridge between this and Manoa Valley to Konaananui triang. sta;
- VI. N. 42° 30' W. " 1510 ft. along the main Konaananui ridge, between this and Kailua, to the Peak overlooking the Nuuanu Pali; Thence
- VII. N. 3° 30' W. " 1860 ft. along said ridge down to the junction, at head of land Kaelouli; Thence
- VIII. N. 38° 20' W. " 1470 ft. along the same ridge between this and Kaelouli to next junction. Thence
- IX. N. 60° 25' W. " 850 ft. along the same ridge to the Nuuanu Pali triangulation signal; Thence
- X. N. 88° 20' W. " 4989 ft. along main ridge and Kailua to Lanihuli Summit; Thence
- XI. N. 60° 00' W. " 760 ft. along the same and Kaneohe to Kailua junction; Thence
- XII. S. 51° 40' W. " 4470 ft. along Kailua Ridge to W. corner of the Keoni Ana award;
- XIII. S. 66° 05' W. " 2140 ft. along the Ridge, and
- XIV. S. 45° 30' W. " 1670 ft. along Kapalama to the head of Waolani Valley; Thence
- XV. S. 24° 30' E. " 800 ft. along Waolani ridge; Thence
- XVI. S. 39° 00' E. " 2500 ft. along the Niniko lot to the Initial Point.

Area, 2220 Acres.



Note: The true summit of this Peak is some 300 ft. higher Eastward. See Kona Survey, C. I. L.

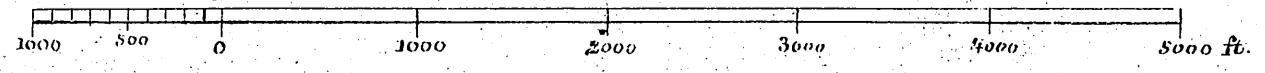
Boundary of Luakaha settled & certified according to this survey - Same as old survey Boundary Com. order March 15-1895.
