Civil Administration - Island Trading Company direct aid to native societies or individuals, such as gratuitous issues of food and clothing, gifts of building materials, etc.

It is no longer necessary to make gratuitous issues of food to the Kili people. This practice has ceased as the people are fully self sufficient. When heavy seas isolate the island so that supplies cannot be landed gratuitous air drops may be necessary. A simple set of signals has been given the people of Kili in order that planes passing over may know of any shortage of food, medical supplies, or other emergency needs.
