15 March 1949- CAU Marshalls
 (Majuro) The meeting of all of the
 Magistrates representing all of the
 various atolls in the Marshall Is.,
 was formally opened by Capt. Ferguson,
 the Civ. Adm. of the Marshall Islands.
 Present at the meeting were Lt. Cdr.
 Andrews, the Ex. Officer, Mr. Kesler,
 the Ed. Adm., Lt. Cucchiara, the Po-
 litical Native Affairs Officer, Moss
 Hone, the reporter, Ferdinand and
 Jetnol, the interpreters, and the
 Magistrates and Scribes from almost
 all of the atolls. A few of the
 atolls were not represented the first
 day, but soon all 23 large atolls in
 the Marshall Is. were represented.

CAPTAIN VEST
VISITS MAGISTRATES MEETING

The final session of the magistrates meeting was called to hear from Capt. Vest, Governor of the Marshalls, who flew down from Kwajalein to speak to the group.

Capt. Vest spoke of the importance of all of the many atolls in the Marshall Islands meeting together and working together. He then outlined progress made in the Marshall Islands and spoke of the increasing of boats that he has made available and will be made available in the future. At present, there are many boats of the 50' variety, which are so badly needed, in Hawaii that will come to the Marshall Islands. Much help in securing these boats was given by Admiral Fiske and Mr. Kesler. Capt. Vest spoke very confidentially of the future of the boat program looking forward to the time when each atoll will have the one or more boats necessary to transport its own copra and trade goods. He advised the group that he had initiated a program for bringing into the Marshall Islands badly needed navigational aids, such things as sextants, compasses, books and charts.

Capt. Vest closed his speech with a word of caution to all of the Marshallese who will operate boats. He spoke of the recent experience of Nuka and the other people in his boat. God was good to them in helping them come back. Some day the Navy will not have boats or airplanes to find ships that are helpless because they have no sails. Boats with sails are fine, boats with sails and motor are fine, boats with motor alone are not good and should never go outside of a lagoon.

PARTIES FOR THE MAGISTRATES

The second party for the magistrates was held by Lt. Cdr. Andrews and the faculty of the Intermediate School at the house of the Executive Officer. Mrs. Andrews, one of the members of the faculty, was the hostess. After refreshment had been served, many pictures were taken of the group. POLITICAL PLAN

Forming the Lawmaking Body of the Marshall Islands:

17 March 1949- CAU Marshalls (Majuro) One of the plans suggested by Capt. E. F. Ferguson was that the Lawmaking Body of the Marshalls will be composed of two houses. One will be the House of Representatives and one will be the House of Iroj. The House of Representatives will be composed of all the members of the municipal officials, such as Magistrates, Scribes, etc.; and the House of Iroj will be composed of all the members of Iroj.

These will make laws subject to approval by the Government. It will probably be four or five years before this plan will begin.

This the same plan used in England to make laws.

ECONOMIC PLAN

17 March 1949- CAU Marshalls (Majuro) This plan was discussed at the Magistrates' meeting held at the school classroom, Education Area. Concerning this plan, it was determined that a \$ 100,00.00 fund should be collected within a period of eighteen-months to form a import and export corporation and company. This \$ 100-00.00 capital will be used in the corporation's commerce and transporting operations.

Mr. Blodgett, the manager of Island Trading Company, questioned the Magistrates to find out if they feel sure that they can handle such a business. Anton De Brun, one of the Magistrates, explained that the present plan is for raising the money necessary; later it will be decided how the company will be run. Probably, an American will be hired to be in charge.

Those decisions which he was unable to put into effect he would favorably endorse.

The first party for the magistrates was held by the Intermediate School students and the members of the faculty. The school auditorium was beautifully decorated and a stage was prepared for the presentation of the program. Several American Officers and friends on the base were present at the party. Everyone seemed to be anxious for the starting of the program, especially the magistrates and the scribes. Finally the opening speech was given by Mr. Kesler, the Ed. Adm., stating that he had promised the magistrates who attended the last conference that he would make a string band available at the school to play for them. "Tonight, he said, the school string band is here and you will see it in its first public appearance. I again promised you that by the time you are here for your next session, you will be entertained by the school brass band!" He also spoke of the sewing and cooking classes taught by Mrs. Andrews that the girls were seen in their new appearance. At the conclusion, Mr. Kesler complimented the magistrates and the scribes for their accomplishments in the meeting.

The program was started with a few Marshallese and American songs followed by dances and the musical entertainments of the boys' band and girls' band. The bands played a few Marshallese and American songs as well as some Hawaiian music. Mr. Blodgett, the ITC manager, who was among the guests, recorded the program in his recording machine. Later in that night, he entertained the magistrates and the scribes as well as the others with the recreation of the program recorded. A few of the magistrates smiled when they heard their own voices come out of the recording machine. Food and refreshments given by Mr. Blodgett, Mr. Kesler, Mr. Rothenberg and the school were served.
