Dear Mr. Myer:

Under date of May 18 you forwarded to the attention of this office copies of a statement concerning question 27 allegedly made by Lieutenant Ray McDaniels at the Heart Mountain Relocation Center on February 12, 1943. The last question and answer read as follows:

**\*FRED MIYASATO:** Regardless of how they answer question No. 27 they will be drafted!

**McDANIELS:** Only if he answers unqualified yes, that means he wishes to volunteer at this time."

After checking the carbon copy of the original transcript signed by both Lieutenant McDaniels and Fred Miyasato, the following is shown to be the correct version:

**\*FRED MIYASATO:** Regardless of how they answer question No. 27, except the unqualified yes, that means he has not volunteered!

**McDANIELS:** Only, if he answers unqualified yes, that means he wishes to volunteer at this time."

I assume you will want to take the necessary steps to correct your records.
