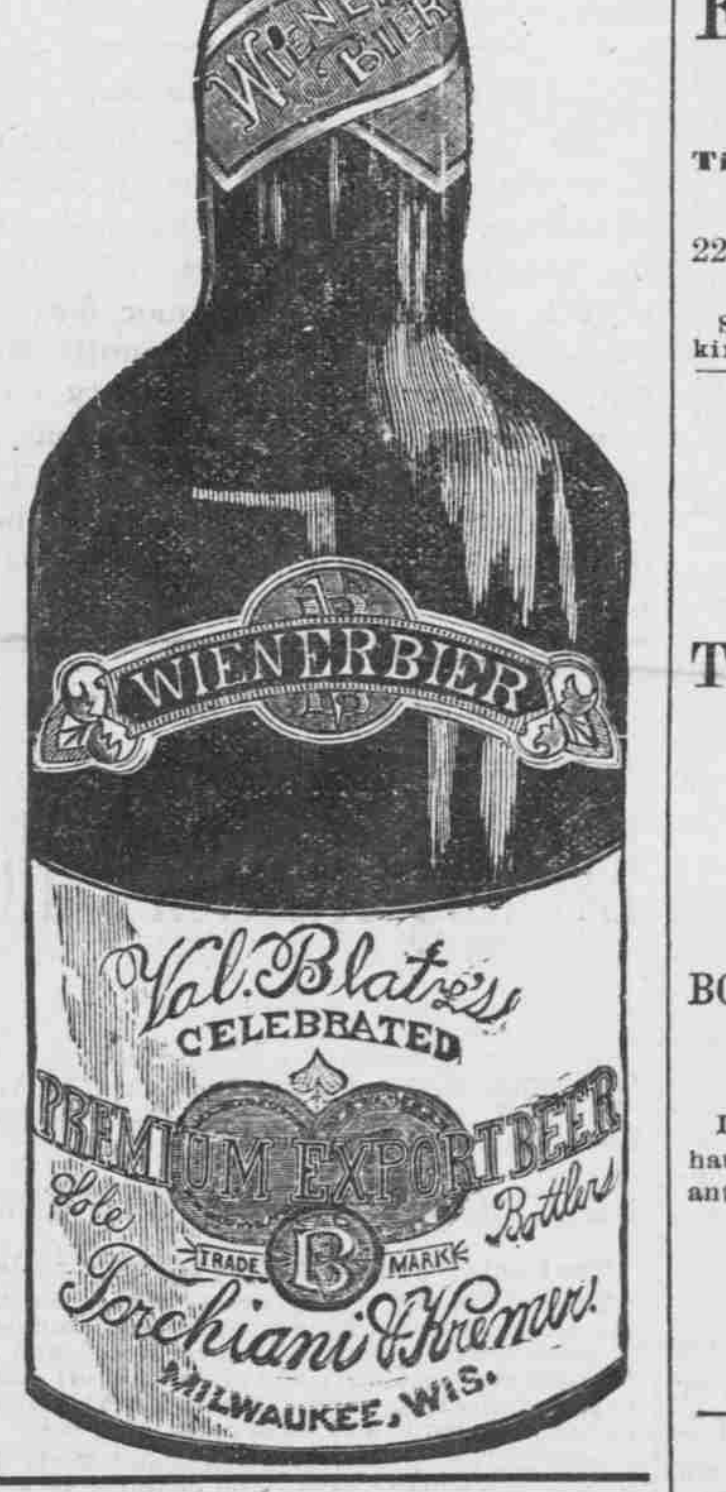

FRIDAY : : : : April 13th THE ATTORNEY GENERAL RETIRES.

During the hearing of the case of Martin vs. Kerr, trespass, in the Supreme Court yesterday Mr. A. S. Hartwell scored a point against the Attorney General, which as a matter of principle was one of some importance.

Section 5. The Attorney General shall not receive any fee or reward from or in behalf of any person or prosecutor, for services rendered in any prosecution or business to which it shall be his official duty to attend; nor be concerned as counsel or attorney for either party in any civil action depending upon the same state of facts.

LEAP YEAR IN THE OLDEN TIME.

It seems that the occurrence of what is called leap year was of some consequence in the olden time, and the peculiar privilege which it seems to confer upon the female sex was given an emphasis and importance by the church which can hardly be claimed for it, or for them, at the present day.

"Albeit is now become a part of the common law, in regard to the social relations of life, that as often as every sixteenth year doth return, the ladies have the privilege during the time it continueth, of making love unto men, which they may do either by words or looks, as unto them it seemeth proper; and, moreover, no man will be entitled to the benefits of the clergy who doth refuse to accept the offers of a ladye, or who doth in anywise treat her proposal with slight or contumely."

It is by no means certain that the "ladies" of the present day would care to have this law re-established. In very few cases only, if any, would a lady care to marry a man who should refuse her offer, and she might possibly be disposed to institute at law a claim for damages.

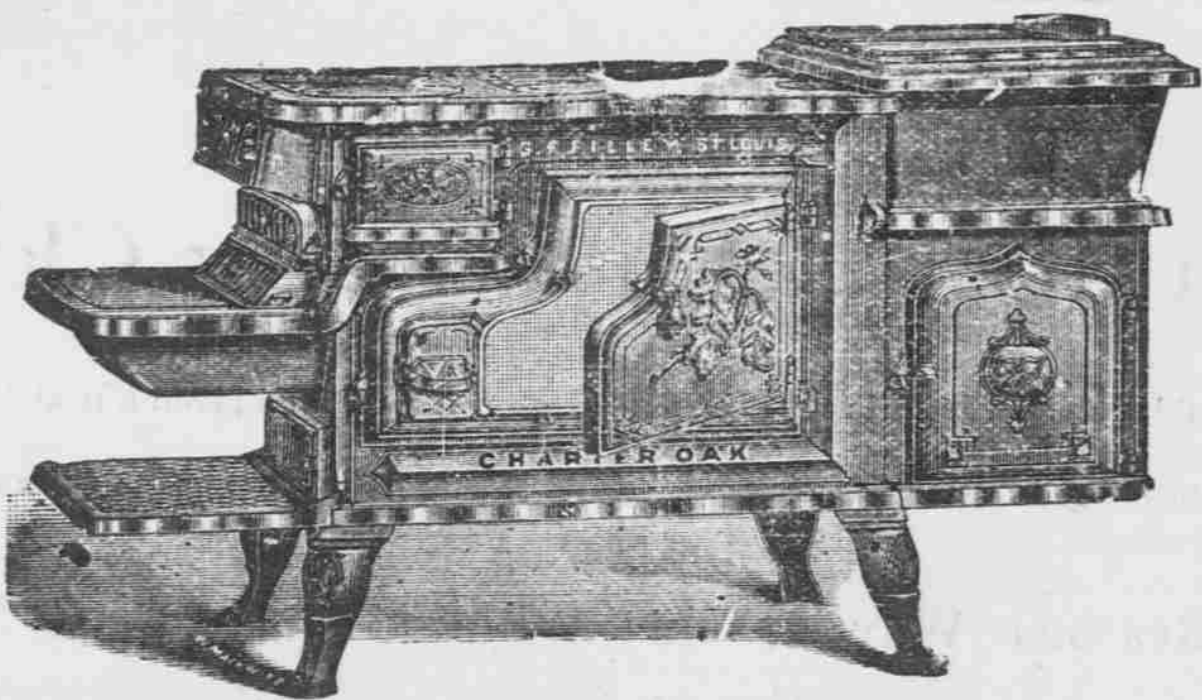
