ALOHA KAKAHIKA! HAUOLI MAKAHIKI HOU!

MAHALO NUI LOA FOR INCLUDING ME IN THE FIRST EVENT OF A YEAR-LONG CELEBRATION FOR HAWAIIANS TO FOCUS ON REMEMBERING THE PAST.

HO'OLAKO..."WE ARE ENRICHED." AS I STAND HERE PROUDLY REMEMBERING THE SPIRITUAL, INTELLECTUAL, EMOTIONAL, PHYSICAL AND SOCIETAL HERITAGE AND CULTURE OF OUR FOREBEARS (KUPUNAS), PROUDLY THINKING OF OUR PO'E HAWAIIANS AND LOOKING AT ALL OF YOU HERE, HAWAIIAN AND HAWAIIAN AT HEART, THE MEANING OF HO'OLAKO IS SELF-EVIDENT. ALL OF US ARE ENRICHED BY THE SHARED CARE AND CONCERN FOR THE PEOPLE AND THE AINA OF HAWAII. THIS YEAR-LONG CELEBRATION WILL UPLIFT THE SPIRIT OF HAWAIIANS AND ALL ETHNIC GROUPS WHO LIVE ON THESE BEAUTIFUL ISLANDS.

I WANT TO ESPECIALLY COMMEND ONE OF HAWAII'S GREAT HAWAIIANS, UNCLE TOMMY KAULUKUKUI, FOR INITIATING AND BRINGING THIS YEAR-LONG CELEBRATION FOR HAWAIIANS TO FRUITION; COMMEND ALL OF WHO WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES.

LOOKING OVER THE CALENDAR OF EVENTS, I COUNTED ALMOST ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES THAT WILL OCCUR THROUGHOUT OUR ISLAND STATE... CELEBRATING AND STRENGTHENING THE HAWAIIAN CULTURE AS IT IS MANIFESTED IN TODAY'S HAWAII...A COMMUNITY INFLUENCED BY ALMOST EVERY CULTURE IN THE WORLD. IN THIS WAY, TODAY'S HAWAII IS UNIQUE FROM ANY OTHER PLACE ON EARTH. IT IS A SPECIAL AINA.

HOWEVER, WHILE WE ARE SO UNIQUE AND SO GEOGRAPHICALLY FAR FROM OTHER LAND AREAS OF THE WORLD, WE ARE ALSO AN IMPORTANT PART OF ONE OF THE GREATEST NATIONS IN THE HISTORY OF THIS WORLD. IN ADDITION TO THIS, WE ARE A VITAL MEMBER OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY...SPECIFICALLY, THE PACIFIC FRONTIER...THE PACIFIC ISLAND NATIONS AND ITS RIM COUNTRIES.

IT IS INSPIRING, JOYOUS AND EXCITING TO THINK ABOUT HAWAII'S PLACE AND MISSION FOR THE WORLD. AS IN OUR LIVES, THIS JOY IS TEMPERED, ENRICHED AND DEEPENED BY THE CHALLENGES THAT EMERGED FROM THE PAST, THE CHALLENGES IN HAWAII'S FUTURE.

LOOKING TO HAWAII'S PAST, WE SEE A GREAT HAWAIIAN, KING KAMEHAMEHA THE FIRST. HE HAD A VISION FOR THE PEOPLE OF HAWAII. HE REALIZED HIS VISION WHEN HE UNITED THE CHIEFDOMS OF THE ISLANDS AND WORKED TO BUILD A PEACEFUL AND ORDERED SOCIETY. WHILE THIS GREAT MAN'S DREAM WAS BEING REALIZED, DESTINY HAD ITS OWN PLANS FOR HAWAII'S FUTURE. FOR WHILE KAMEHAMEHA WAS UNITING HIS NATION IN THE LATE 18th CENTURY, ANOTHER NATION WAS BEING FORMED UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF A MAN WHO HAD SOME OF THE SAME QUALITIES AS KAMEHAMEHA.

GEORGE WASHINGTON, THE FIRST PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND ONE OF ITS FOUNDING FATHERS, HAD A VISION SIMILAR TO KAMEHAMEHA'S...A NATION UNITED IN PEACE. I AM SURE THAT IF THESE TWO CONTEMPORARIES COULD HAVE KNOWN EACH OTHER, THEY WOULD HAVE FELT GREAT MUTUAL ADMIRATION AND RESPECT.

ALTHOUGH THEY NEVER MET, THEIR LEGACIES DID MEET...SOME MIGHT SAY THEIR LEGACIES COLLIDED AND THAT THE HAWAIIANS TOOK THE BRUNT OF THE IMPACT. FROM A PARADISE THAT EVOLVED FROM CHIEFDOMS INTO A MONARCHY, THE KINGDOM OF HAWAII WAS FORCED INTO BECOMING A REPUBLIC, A TERRITORY AND FINALLY, ONE OF THE STATES OF GEORGE WASHINGTON'S GREAT DREAM. THIS ALL HAPPENED IN A RELATIVELY SHORT TIME AND VERY LITTLE CONSIDERATION WAS GIVEN TO NATIVE HAWAIIANS.

FOR THOSE OF US WHO ARE HAWAIIAN, THIS HISTORY BRINGS MIXED FEELINGS BECAUSE OF THE INJUSTICES INFLICTED ON THE HAWAIIAN PEOPLE. THE TASK HAS NOW FALLEN ON US TO CREATE A VISION AND A COURSE OF ACTION FOR THE FUTURE OF OUR STATE. THE PAIN IS REAL. AND, THE CHALLENGES THAT WE FACE TODAY ARE MONUMENTAL. IN AREAS SUCH AS HEALTH, EDUCATION AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY, MUCH PROGRESS MUST BE MADE. FORTUNATELY, WE CAN ALSO SAY THAT GREAT STRIDES HAVE BEEN MADE IN RECENT YEARS BY THE HAWAIIAN PEOPLE. FOR EXAMPLE, THE HIGHEST ELECTIVE OFFICE IN OUR STATE IS HELD BY A MAN NAMED JOHN WAIHE'E. THE LEADER OF THE STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IS CURRENTLY HENRY PETERS, A HAWAIIAN. OUR STATE SENATE IS LED BY PRESIDENT RICHARD WONG WHO IS ALSO HAWAIIAN. AND RECENTLY, A PART-HAWAIIAN NAMED HENRY GIUGNI, WHO PREVIOUSLY WAS A TOP AIDE TO SENATOR INOUE, WAS APPOINTED BY THE SENATE LEADERSHIP AS SERGEANT OF ARMS OF THAT BODY. AN INTERESTING ASIDE IS THE FACT THAT MOST PEOPLE DON'T KNOW THAT HENRY IS THE FIRST HAWAIIAN WITH THE POWER TO ARREST THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES. INTERESTING IN THAT PEOPLE PURPORTING TO REPRESENT THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT ILLEGALLY ARRESTED OUR BELOVED QUEEN LILIUOKALANI AND NOW WE HAVE A HAWAIIAN WHO HAS THE LEGAL AUTHORITY TO ARREST THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

THE PEOPLE I HAVE JUST MENTIONED, AND THERE ARE MANY, MANY OTHERS, SHOW WHAT HEIGHTS PEOPLE OF HAWAIIAN ANCESTRY CAN RISE TO IN TODAY'S WORLD. IT IS UP TO THOSE OF US WHO HAVE REACHED POSITIONS OF STATURE TO HELP THOSE WHO ARE BURDENED AND REPPRESSED BY THE INJUSTICES OF THE PAST.

AS WE ALL KNOW, GREAT STRIDES HAVE BEEN MADE BY AND FOR MANY HAWAIIANS IN OUR STATE. BUT AS FAR AS WE HAVE COME, WE ARE STILL JUST BEGINNING OUR TASK TO PROVIDE ALL THE HAWAIIANS IN OUR STATE WITH THE TOOLS AND RESOURCES THAT WILL ENABLE THEM TO DETERMINE THEIR OWN FUTURES...THIS IS PERHAPS OUR GREATEST CHALLENGE, AND I PLEDGE TO YOU THAT I WILL DO ALL I CAN IN CONGRESS TO HELP. WE ARE NOW WORKING WITH AGENCIES SUCH AS THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS, ALU LIKE, E OLA MAU AND THE KEMEHAMEHA SCHOOLS TO MEET THIS CHALLENGE.

ALTHOUGH THEY NEVER MET, THEIR LEGACIES DID MEET...SOME MIGHT SAY THEIR LEGACIES COLLIDED AND THAT THE HAWAIIANS TOOK THE BRUNT OF THE ^{IMPACT} COLLISION. AND, THE CHALLENGES THAT WE FACE TODAY ARE GREAT IN AREAS SUCH AS HEALTH, EDUCATION AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY, ~~THERE IS~~ MUCH PROGRESS ^{MUST} TO BE MADE. AND RECENTLY, A PART-HAWAIIAN NAMED HENRY GIUGNI, WHO PREVIOUSLY ^{WAS A TOP AIDE TO} WORKED FOR SENATOR INOUE, WAS APPOINTED BY THE SENATE LEADERSHIP AS SERGEANT OF ARMS FOR THAT BODY. THIS ^{PRESENTS} AN INTERESTING ^{FACT} THAT MANY PEOPLE IN THE NATION'S CAPITOL DON'T KNOW ^{AND MAY NOT WISH TO KNOW...} HENRY IS THE FIRST HAWAIIAN WITH THE POWER TO ARREST THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, INTERESTING IN THAT...

THE PEOPLE I HAVE JUST MENTIONED, AND THERE ARE MANY, MANY OTHERS, SHOW WHAT HEIGHTS PEOPLE OF HAWAIIAN ANCESTRY CAN RISE TO IN TODAY'S WORLD. IT IS UP TO THOSE OF US WHO HAVE REACHED POSITIONS OF STATURE TO HELP THOSE WHO ARE BURDENED AND HELD DOWN BY THE INJUSTICES OF THE PAST.

AS WE ALL KNOW, GREAT STRIDES HAVE BEEN MADE FOR MANY HAWAIIANS IN OUR STATE. BUT AS FAR AS WE HAVE COME, WE ARE STILL JUST BEGINNING IN OUR TASK TO PROVIDE ALL THE HAWAIIANS IN OUR STATE WITH THE TOOLS AND RESOURCES THAT WILL ENABLE THEM TO DETERMINE THEIR OWN FUTURES...THIS IS PERHAPS OUR GREATEST CHALLENGE, AND I PLEDGE TO YOU THAT I WILL DO ALL I CAN IN CONGRESS TO HELP. WE ARE NOW WORKING WITH AGENCIES SUCH AS THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS, ^{AWAHIKE,} E OLA MAU AND THE KAMEHAMEHA SCHOOLS TO MEET THIS CHALLENGE.
