MEMORANDUM FOR MAJOR LAHEDALE:

Subject: Voluntary Induction of Loyal
Japanese-Americans 20 Years of
Age and not over 45.

1. As Miss Lynch has probably told you, Colonel Gibson of G-1 indicates that the age group from 20 to 45, inclusive, is eligible for the Japanese-American combat team.

2. Attached is letter from Mr. Galvin of Colorado River Relocation Center with reference to three overage men. Miss Lynch tells me that there were other overage volunteers.

3. As I stated in my reply to Mr. Galvin, copy also attached, it seems to me that steps should be taken to bring their induction into the service if otherwise qualified; the same should apply to other overage volunteers.
