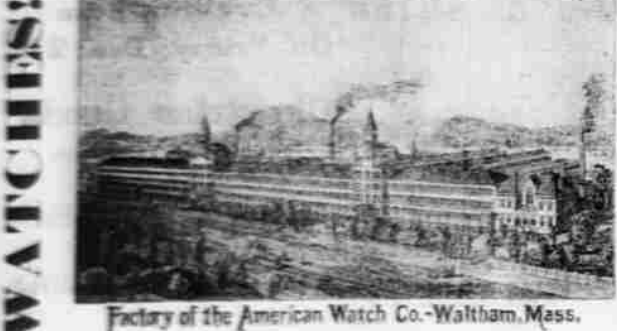

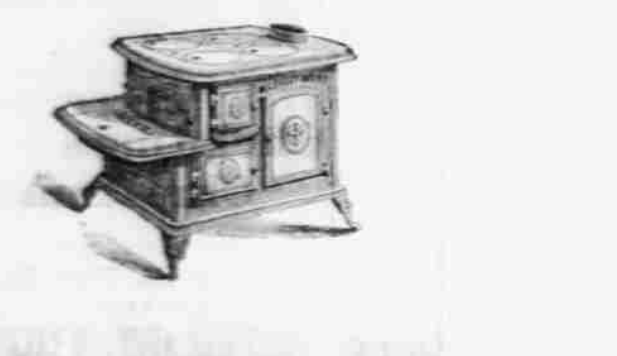

TUMAS.
Wind and weather permitting, the statue of
Dumas will be inaugurated on the 4th
November, on the place Malesherbes, facing
Monsieur's studio and check by Jovi with
Sara Bernhardt's wigwam. At that ceremony
political lines and lambs will meet in peace.
A celebrity who amused France so long, and
whose works will continue to do so, despite
new constitutions and novelists in sea, for
many years to come. Dumas died at the age
of 67, in December, 1870, at his son's resi-
dence, 1 rue, near Dreyfus, and his remains
were later definitely interred at Villers Catter-
ets, where he was born. His grand-father,
who was a Marquis, married an African
negress, that which explained the woolly nature
of his locks, and the gingerbread color of his
features. His father was a general who left
his mark during the wars of the revolution
and the empire. Dumas, with his father when
four years old; the widow was left with one
son and two daughters, plenty of debts and no
income. Dumas never received any education
except the primer and the rudiments of Latin
which he taught himself. He was a self-taught
author; he executed his own editing, but he
could not read the French of his father.
He was a naturalist's office. Here he was taught
