

Sir;

During our present assignment of duty here at Manzanar Relocation Center for the completion of the New Nisei Volunteer Combat Unit, we have encountered many new problems. Utmost in our mind through contacts and observation is the lack of a Nisei unit of W.A.A.C. The many Nisei's here have spent their entire life in and around the surrounding of California where their social life was a leading factor. Under the present circumstances they feel reluctant to a degree to volunteer because they feel that the women should also be able to volunteer their services. Through our present censorship we find many Nisei women who are willing and ready to join in the participation of our country's defense. We wish to recommend at the earliest possible time the completion of the Nisei W.A.A.C. to be able to present it to the Nisei American Citizens everywhere as another step towards the complete acceptance of their pledge to our country.

We believe this would be of the greatest importance towards a completion of our present duty for the new unit of the United States Army.
