Dear Mother,

We the comrades of your son Robert want to express our sympathy for you as you mourn his passing. May you receive comfort and strength from the Heavenly Father in this time of sorrow.

Sgt. Robert K. Nakasaki, 39017321, Company A of the 100th Battalion, was killed in action in Northern Italy on April 5, 1945. He was hit on the forehead by an enemy bullet while advancing toward an enemy position; he was bravely performing his duty up to the moment of death. He was given a proper burial and now rests in an American Cemetery in Northern Italy; later on the Quartermaster General (Washington, D. C.) will tell you the exact location of his grave. And you will receive his personal belongings through army channels.

We remember you, loved ones of our fallen buddies, each time we offer prayer at our battalion church services. God bless you, good Mother, and all your son's loved ones.
