RE: READY TO LEARN CAMPAIGN

I have attached some background information for you regarding the Ready to Learn Program. As you will see, Dan and Maggie are the honorary co-chairs.

This program seeks to raise funds and collect school supplies for needy children. Maggie shoot a commercial which is on air now encouraging people to make a donation and bring it to any of the DKI in 98 headquarters or First Hawaiian Bank branches.

In light of the sagging economy, the number of children in need continues to rise, we are up to 30,000+ children statewide. The plan is to package the basic supplies and then working with the social service agencies distribute them to the children right before school begins. The program ends with a family day celebration and distribution of a part of the school supplies on August 23rd at Bishop Museum.

This project is linked to a private non-profit, Community Clearinghouse, and as such, all contributions are tax-deductible. Also, we can accept corporate monies and foreign monies which as you know are banned to us on the campaign side.

Walter has given \$10,000 + a host of in-kind services and access to all of his branches, print shop, as well as set up an employee drive. I have a commitment from Campbell Estate for \$25,000, and AT&T for between \$5 - \$10,000. We are now in the process of hitting our list once again. It is going to take about \$500,000 in cash and school supply donations.

Can you see whether Cassidy or some of your clients could make a donation - corporate, tax-deductible money to the Ready to Learn program. How about Gary Brown of Lockheed for example (I know they are finalists for the PMRF contract, together with DynCorp). We have a short fuse on this. Anything you can do would be very helpful. Thanks.

Each year the Community Clearinghouse, under the auspices of a private nonprofit organization called Helping Hands Hawaii, collects school supplies for needy children in Hawaii. In past years, they were able to outfit an average of 2,000 to 3,500 children. Last year the Clearinghouse serviced 13,970 requests on Oahu, a nearly 400% increase over the previous year.

In 1998, requests for assistance are anticipated to be about 20,000 children on Oahu and more than 10,000 on Neighbor Islands. This is an alarming projection and a daunting challenge.

That is why Maggie and I are helping to lead the charge for the Ready to Learn '98 campaign. As a former teacher, Maggie knows first-hand the positive impact a solid educational foundation has on a child, as well as the tragic consequences of deprivation.

In fact, this is so important that we are making this project a part of our campaign and are encouraging all of our friends and supporters to help us meet the goal of ensuring that all of Hawaii's children are ready to learn – with pencils, paper, rulers and crayons – and an alert mind and a happy smile.

These are our future leaders, tomorrow's scientists, teachers and U.S. Senators. Please consider a generous contribution or donation of school supplies as an investment in Hawaii's future.

FACT SHEET

Honorary Chairs: U.S. Senator & Mrs. Daniel K. Inouye

Prior to 1997, requests to the Community Clearinghouse for school supply assistance averaged between 2,000 and 3,500 per year.

In 1997, the Clearinghouse received and serviced 13,970 requests -- a record for the agency from Oahu families. Despite this first time achievement, hundreds of children were turned away because of a shortage of available supplies and resources.

This year, the Clearinghouse estimates that requests for school supply assistance will reach or exceed 20,000 Oahu children. Our goal in this year's school supply drive, Ready to Learn '98, is 20,000+ children from grades kindergarten through 12 for the island of Oahu and an additional 10,000 children from the Neighbor Islands.

School supplies donated on the Neighbor Islands will remain on those islands for distribution to needy island school children there.

KHON-TV2 and KITV-4 are media partners in this project. KHON-TV2 will be advertising their Lokahi Back-to-School Program in July 1998. KITV-4's School Tools Program will follow in early August 1998. The project will conclude in late August with a Community Clearinghouse Family Day at Bishop Museum (open to the general public).

Financial contributions for the Ready to Learn '98 project should be made to "Ready to Learn." All contributions are tax-deductible.

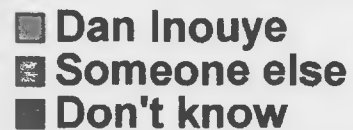

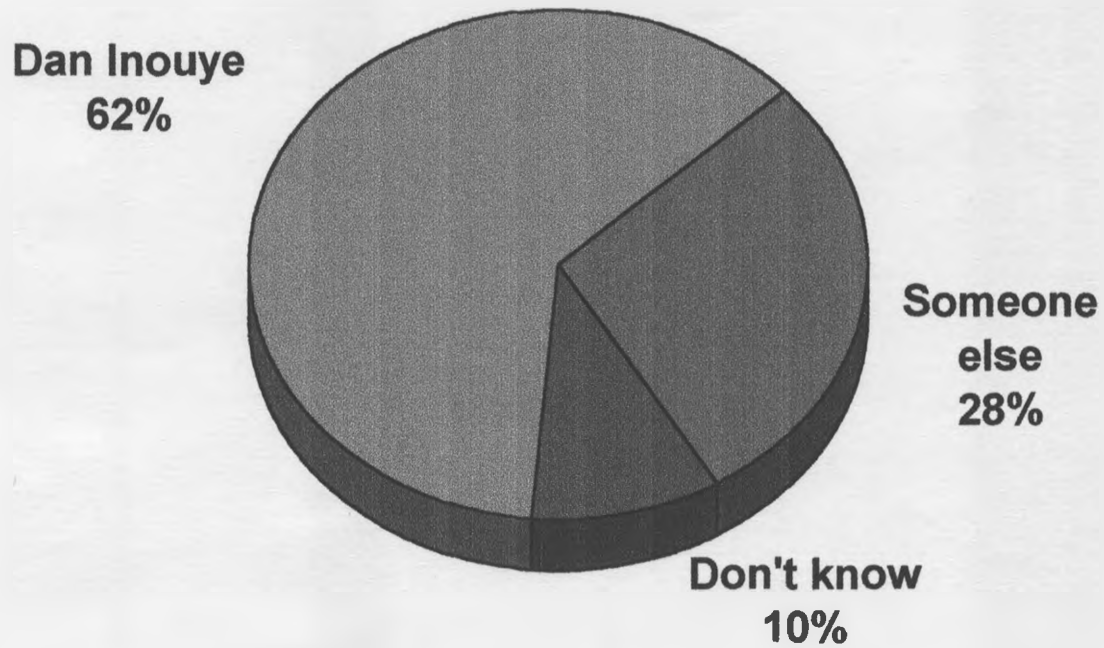

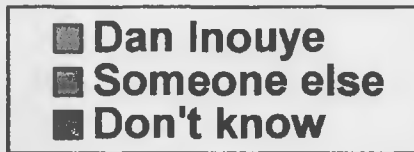
