REPAIRS OF GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS.—The works of the Prison, Court House, Custom House, and the Store occupied by Messrs Peirce & Co., have been renewed, or repaired to a considerable extent.

New Post Office.—This building has been completed at a cost considerably in excess of the appropriation for that purpose.

New Steamboat Wharf.—The extension of this wharf towards Fisherman's Point, making a frontage of 600 feet, is nearly completed.

New Wharves and Berths of Wharves.—A new sea wall of one hundred yards in length has been built in the rear of the new steamboat wharf to protect the new made ground.

Dredging Machine.—The Dredging Machine having been thoroughly repaired, and four new screws for transporting the cans built, the work of dredging has been vigorously prosecuted for the last fourteen months with very gratifying results.

The success of the attempt to deepen the harbor at the foot of the Esplanade without blasting, which had hitherto been deemed indispensable—has been thus far complete, and it is hoped that a few months more work will be sufficient to make the harbor available for vessels of the largest class.

It is now asked for Dredging in the present Appropriation Bill, it will probably be sufficient to make the harbor complete, and equal to all probable requirements.

NEW GOVERNMENT OFFICES.—The building of these offices has been retarded, on account of a question as to the ownership of the plot on which the offices are to be erected.

COMPLETION OF EXTENSION OF SCHOOL STREET.—Nothing has been done under this appropriation, the amount granted being no more than sufficient for the necessary labor and material.
