Very little gratuitous issue has been made by USNMGU or USCC partly because materials have not been available and partly because it is contrary to general policy. No food or clothing was given. A few items not available by purchase such as large spikes and waste lumber was given for construction of First Aid buildings, all-men houses and guest-houses. In addition, 24 sheets of used quonset metal was awarded to each of two men for construction purposes. They were not given as gratuitous issue, however, but as rewards for meritorious and outstanding work for MGU.
