

Fifty one natives were treated for yaws on the field trip. These treatments were mainly for infantile Yaws. All children were examined and those showing symptoms were treated. Eleven natives were examined for worms infestation at the MGU Dispensary, Kwajalein during February. One positive examination was found for Trichuris Trichiura and one for Necator Americanus. All other examinations were negative for worms. Thirteen blood tests for yaws were taken. Seven turned out positive and three were doubtful.
