Thanks again for providing time for Senator Akaka to join us at Kalihi Elementary. The school was not able to participate in the regularly scheduled Teach Children To Save Day and opted to hold its TCTS Day on April 28th, which worked out great. Just fyi, the sessions are being facilitated by BOH volunteers who work with the teachers on specific topics geared for certain grade levels. There will be two classes being held during the time the Senator will be at the school (1 p.m. – 1:30 p.m.) We thought it might be fun for him to visit one class for about 15 minutes and then move to the second classroom. Here are some of the key logistical details:

Date: Thursday, April 28, 2011

Location: Kalihi Elementary (2472 Kula Kolea Drive).

Time: 1 p.m.

Class #1: 12:45 – 1:30 p.m. "What Does It Cost Now?" Grade 5; 57 students

Class #2: 1:15 -1:45 p.m. "Patty's Pet Hamster" Grade 2; 44 students

Parking: There will be a reserved parking stall at the top of the hill (1st stall near the Office). A custodian will be there to direct the Senator to the stall.

Driving Directions:

- Take the H-1 going West
- Take the Likelike exit (exit 20A)
- Turn slight left onto Likelike Hwy (about 1.4 mi. on Likelike)
- Turn left onto Kula Kolea Dr. (at the light by the pedestrian bridge)
- Take first right to stay on Kula Kolea Dr.
- Kalihi Elementary (2471 Kula Kolea Dr.) will be on the right hand side
- Turn into first driveway and go all the way up the hill
- The office will be at the top of the hill

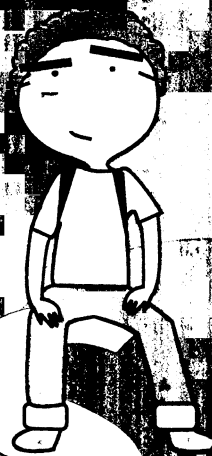


