LATE FOREIGN ITEMS! The President's new plan—The Times special dispatch says the following is the amendment to the Constitution proposed by the President: ARTICLE 14.—Section 1. No State has the right to secede, nor has the Federal Government the right to secede from a State or to deprive it of representation in Congress. The United States debt shall be held sacred and inviolate. The rebel debt shall never be paid by the nation nor any State. Sec. 2. All persons born or naturalized in the United States, and subject to its jurisdiction, shall be citizens and shall have rights and immunities of citizens in all the States.
