

(a) Summary Provost Court. Uliga Island, Majuro Atoll. USNMGU.

(b) Two native contract laborers and a labor camp policeman engaged in a free-for-all brawl New Years Day and were arrested and placed in the brig overnight to await trial on charges of drunkenness and disturbing the peace. A Summary Provost Court was held and the three were found guilty. The policeman was reduced to the lowest pay grade (\$12.00) for a period of three months and put on probation and his badge removed. His regular pay was \$15.00 monthly. The two contract laborers were given forty-hours of extra work to perform. The sentence of this court was approved by the Commanding Officer who sat in on the proceedings.
