

Preventive Medicine and Therapeutic Field Work: Typhoid inoculations were begun on Mokol, Pingelap and Kusaie and continued by the native hospital corpsman. For a description of the therapeutic measures accomplished see report of field trip in appendix.

The Senior Medical Officer made a visit to the Metalanim dispensary during the month timing it to cover the yaws treatment day. The primary purpose of this visit was the concern felt about recurrence of yaws as described in paragraph 1 (c) above. The technic of the native corpsman was found to be satisfactory and his diagnoses objectively accurate. However it is even more true in the outlying districts that patients do not continue treatment once their lesions have healed than it is at the main dispensary. Another inspection of this nature is planned for the Kitti district in the near future.
