(4) Development and expansion of program: results:

During this quarter the first native health aides were rotated from their islands back into the dispensary and men sent out from the dispensary to replace them. This system of rotation promises to be very effective as a means of improving the work of the trained health aides staffing sub-dispensaries. Special emphasis is being given to improving the reporting that these aides will be expected to do on their return. Their special problems are discussed and they are assigned duties in the main dispensary which will improve them in the fields in which they themselves feel the need for more training.
